



Official CMG MET Police Drone Handbook

This handbook will take you through the basics of operating a drone as well as the circumstances of when you should use one. Do not take out a drone unless you are eligible and are trained with the use of one.

Who's eligible?

- Senior Advanced Driver
- Advanced Driver
- Special Vehicle Response Team & Unmarked RPU
- NPAS [Pilot+]
- Divisional Command
- OFC
- CTSFO
- TRO
- Bronze Command

When to use them?

- Foot Pursuits
- Area searches
- Breaching a building
- Missing persons

Remember you must NEVER take out a drone when inside of a building. You should also make sure the area where you are launching your drone is clear of pedestrians or any obstacles. Also bear in mind the signal strength of the drone is 2km. So keep it close.

Controls for the drone

/drone - This will set up a drone on the floor in front of you, run this command again to delete it.

- **Q** - Fly up, increasing altitude
- **Z** or **E** - Fly down, decreasing altitude
- **Backward Arrow** - Move the drone backward
- **Forward Arrow** - Move the drone forwards
- **Left Arrow** - Rotate the drone to the left
- **Right Arrow** - Rotate the drone to the right
- **Enter** - Enters into the drone camera
- **2** - Toggle night vision
- **1** - Toggle thermal imaging
- **Insert** - Automatically land the drone
- **W** - Camera up
- **A** - Camera to the left
- **S** - Camera down
- **D** - Camera to the right
