These instructions will guide you through combining shapes/paths in Inkscape.

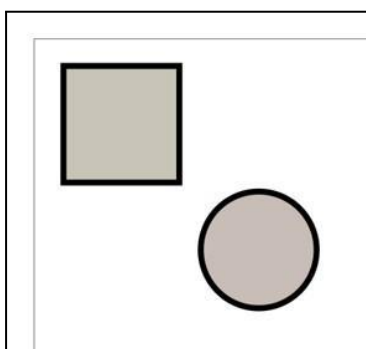
The latest version of Inkscape was used at the time of creating this resource (Inkscape 0.92). Note that there may be differences between versions.

Task Combine shapes/paths using intersection

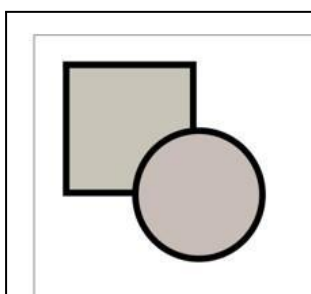
Steps

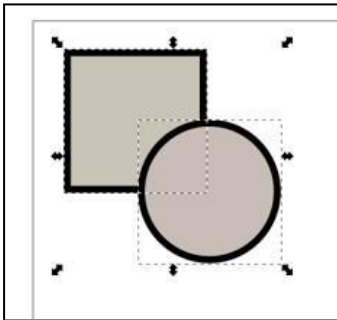
1. **Create two** new different shapes/paths.



2. **Overlap** the shapes/paths.

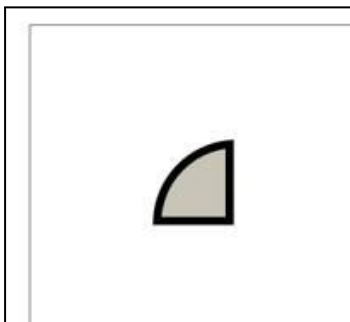
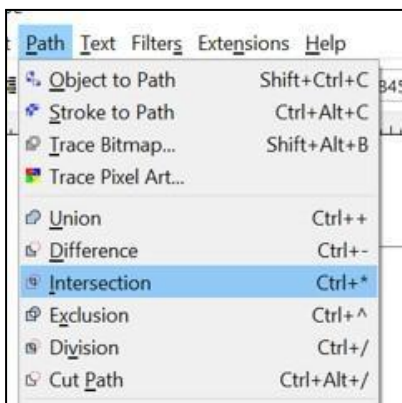


3. **Select** the shapes/paths.



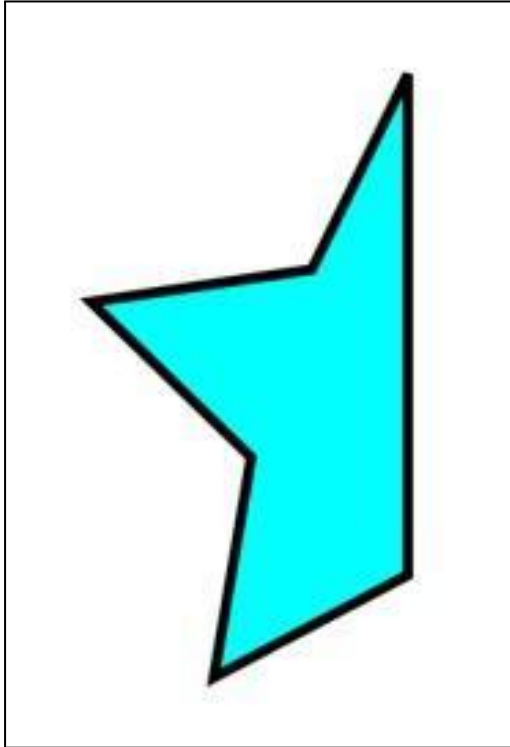
4. **Combine** the shapes/paths using intersection.

Use the menu **Path** > **Intersection** or use the keyboard shortcut **Ctrl + ***.



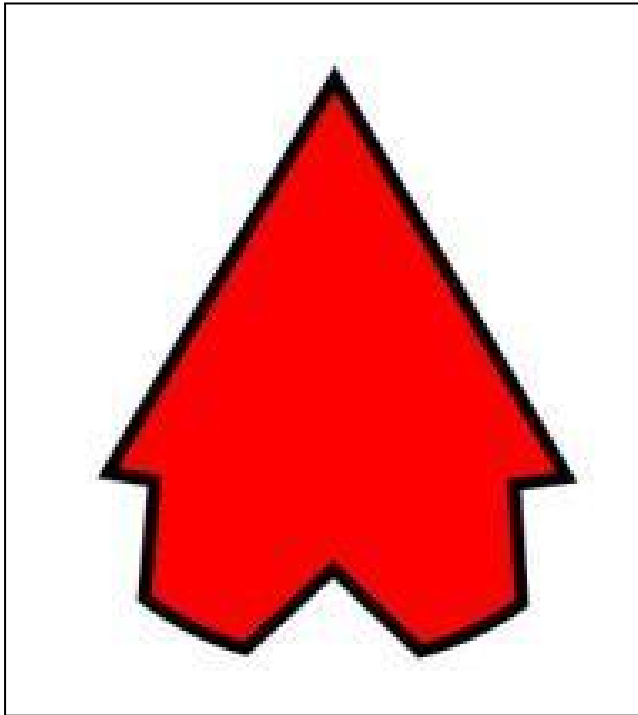
Only the overlapping part of the shapes/paths will remain.
