Starting Points for Christian Educators, Sunday School Teachers, and Youth Leaders

Outside of the Advent calendar for kids (found here), which follows the larger Sunday programming, we're providing one activity suggestion per week that might work with your community for an extra meeting like a Sunday school or youth group. For those who want to dig deeper, we highly recommend Christian educators acquire, read, and adapt this resource: Teaching Palestine: Lessons, Stories, Voices, edited by Bill Bigelow, Jesse Hagopian, Suzanna Kassouf, Adam Sanchez, and Samia Shoman.

1st Week of Advent

- HOPE: Make Palestinian poppies. Discuss resilience. Center yourselves on images of plants that grow out of nothing. Tell stories of the most beautiful flower you've ever seen with the group.

3rd Week of Advent

• JOY: Make a <u>protest sign</u> for your community to participate in a <u>liturgical direct</u> action together (actions like those found over at our friends at Christians for a Free Palestine (CFP) <u>here!</u>) Discuss how collective action and praying with our feet can be joyful.

4th Week of Advent

• LOVE: Write a letter to someone you love and give it to them this week. Discuss how community is how we birth movements toward liberation. Discuss the people who showed up to love Jesus in his first few years of life. How did Jesus keep community at the forefront in his life?

Christmastide & Epiphany

- MANIFESTATION: Make kites for Gaza. (Related options for further action around kite crafting below in link.) Discuss how art and imagination is one way we manifest God in the world. Discuss what you want to manifest for Gaza and for all Palestinians in 2026.








Advent 3 - Joy (The Shepherd's Candle)

- Kairos Palestine Kairos Palestine is a Palestinian Christian ecumenical movement rooted in the historic Moment of Truth document issued in 2009 (linked below as Kairos 1). Born from the lived reality of suffering, steadfast faith, and the longing for justice, the Kairos Palestine movement raises a prophetic voice against the ongoing oppression in Palestine. The original Kairos Document (linked below as Kairos 1) stands as the collective word of Palestinian Christians to the world; a cry of hope grounded in love, prayer, and unwavering faith in God. It speaks first to our own Palestinian community and then calls upon churches and Christians everywhere to reject injustice and apartheid, and to work courageously for a just and lasting peace.

As allies to Palestinian Christians living in Palestine, it's important that we study these documents faithfully.
