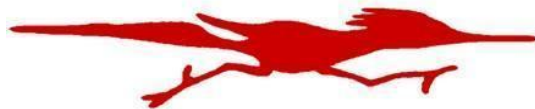

ALL IN Roadrunners Strategic Planning for Instructional Effectiveness Hulet Elementary 2019-2025

Goal: By May 2025, Hulet Elementary will ensure all students demonstrate academic growth and acquire skills to become productive citizens.

- **Strategy:** Meet the needs of all students through Response to Intervention (RTI) and Intervention Assistance Team (IAT).
 - o **Evidence:** Tier II Behavior Intervention Supports, the use of Reading Interventionist
- **Strategy:** Deepen student learning through real-world connections, cross-curricular content integration, project-based learning, and performance-based assessments.
- **Strategy:** Expand effective instructional practices through increased teacher collaboration, teacher modeling, and co-teaching opportunities.
 - o **Evidence:** Professional Learning Communities, Year 1 and 2 Mentor programs, peer-to-peer observations through Pineapple Chart.
- **Strategy:** Maintain one-to-one technology which will help prepare students for jobs that have yet been created.
 - o **Evidence:** 1 Chromebook to every 2 students at Hulet Elementary.
 - o **Evidence:** 2 Chromebooks to every one student at Hulet Elementary as of August 17, 2022

Goal: By May 2025, Hulet Elementary will ensure all students learn in a supportive, safe, and nurturing environment.

- **Strategy:** Incorporate Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports with fidelity.
 - o **Evidence:** Tier 1 PBIS implemented with 85% fidelity as identified by Tiered Fidelity Indicator; Decrease of out-of-school suspension rates
 - o **Evidence:** Tier 1 PBIS implemented with 92% fidelity as identified by the Tiered Fidelity Indicator with an outside evaluator in May 2022.
- **Strategy:** Establish anti-bullying campaigns that expand beyond Kindness Week.
 - o **Evidence:** Establishment of the Spirit Committee and the Equity Committee in Fall of 2022
- **Strategy:** Provide professional development on classroom management, teacher-student relationship building, de-escalation, implicit bias, and behavior intervention plans.
 - o **Evidence:** Behavior Specialist Classroom Support, Restorative Justice, and Reset/Refocus Room
- **Strategy:** Provide student leadership opportunities
 - o **Evidence:** PAX Leaders
- **Strategy:** Restructure in-school suspension to integrate strategies to change inappropriate behaviors.
 - o **Evidence:** Reset and Refocus Room, Behavior Specialist Classroom Support

Goal: By May 2025, Hulet Elementary will strengthen family engagement and community investment.

- **Strategy:** Enhance family outreach and communication tools to impact student success.
 - **Evidence:** Classroom newsletters, monthly school newsletter, Academic Parent-Teacher Teams, Frequent Social Media posts
 - **Evidence:** Implementation of Academic Parent Teacher Teams (APTT) in Fall 2021.
 - **Evidence:** Parent feedback highly praised APTT implementation and encouraged the continued implementation in Spring of 2022.
