- 1. Create a vision and goals for the group
- 2. Have an Action Plan/Project Writing Workshop presented by the new member
- 3. Attend an Educational Speaker of the new member's choice and discuss as a group
- 4. Leadership Book-of-the-Month facilitated by new members
- 5. Have a Discussion about the relevance of the mission.
- 6. Building an action event workshop presented by one of the organizers
- 7. Participate in a recruitment workshop
- 8. Snacks, movie, and a trivia game
- 9. Plan a fundraiser to pay for conference attendance fees
- 10. Encourage active membership in at least one organization outside the group
- 11. Evaluate the process during and after new member education
- 12. Develop a family inclusion activity
- 13. Discuss risk management and liability
- 14. Brainstorm ways to recruit new members to present to the group
- 15. Have a "Meet Our New Members" event
- 16. Attend an eco-program or event another group/organization is sponsoring
- 17. Have a group goal-setting retreat at a unique gathering location or in nature
- 18. Ask new members to accompany members to regional environmental action leadership conferences
- 19. Attend a local, regional or national leadership conference
- 20. Ask the Mayor to discuss city issues and how the group can help.
- 21. Develop or co-sponsor a program or event with another group
- 22. Have a new member create a piece of marketing content from the resource library to share with the group at a meeting.
- 23. Ask each member to list the offices/chairs they would be interested in and ask him or her to list five things they would do differently about each. Compile results without names attached and have a constructive conversation.
