



## **Shotgun Choice**

**\*\*FFA Sporting Clays...Regional and State competition states that participants may use their own shotgun, but to compete in those two competitions the shotgun must be an over and under shotgun. If a competitor does not have an over and under shotgun one will be provided by the school or by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife for the competition.**

**O/U vs Semi-Auto:** O/U allows for the participant to have two different chokes in their shotgun. Semi-Autos are generally lighter and depending on the shotgun the shooter has less felt recoil.

### **Barrel Length Sporting Clays (FFA Shooting)**

28-inch: Light and fast, great for beginning shooters because of the weight and swings smoothly

\*30-inch: Ideal because of the balance with more weight on the barrel end of the shotgun, still swings smoothly and good for those longer shots.

32-in: Provides a longer sight plane but can feel heavy for smaller shooters.

### **Barrel Length for Trap**

\*30-inch: Great overall choice for beginners to experienced shooters.

32 inch or 34 inch: Top choice for experienced or professional shooters.

### **Barrel Length for Skeet**

28 inch: Smooth swing and good weight for beginner shooters.

\*30 inch: Top choice for advanced shooters, good balance and smooth swing.

32 inch: The go to for professional shooters, great visual plane and heavier barrel weight.
