

Organic Recordkeeping Resource Now Available for Producers



The Northwest Transition to Organic Partnership Program (NW TOPP) has a new recordkeeping video series available to help producers who are interested in organic certification learn more about the recordkeeping process from the perspectives of an Organic Inspector and certified organic producers.

The “Trail of Records” is a five-part video series where Matthew Molyneaux, Technical Specialist and Organic Inspector of 15 years, provides an overview of the organic recordkeeping process. In the series, Matthew goes over the recordkeeping requirements for seeds, seedlings, and planting stock; planting and production activities; input materials; harvest and storage; and sales and transactions. Each video in this series is 5-10 minutes long.

In addition to the “Trail of Records”, NW TOPP has a Mentor Recordkeeping Series where certified organic producers share an in-depth look at their own recordkeeping processes. In this series, producers interested in organic certification can learn from NW TOPP mentors.
