Real World Connection

Making inferences is something we do all day long without even thinking. We draw from what we know from past experiences to help us make a good choice or to help us understand something.

For example:

How many of you have a pet? If your pet is a puppy and will chew on things left on the floor - what will you do to keep your things safe while you are at school?

Or

When mom got home from work she asked if you had a good time swimming but you did not tell her you had gone swimming. How might she have figured that out?

- Before reading - ask a few background questions
 - Look at the cover, what do you think this story will be about?
 - Who is the author? Who is the illustrator?
- During reading the story - continue to ask questions to check for understanding
 - What is the setting of the story?
 - What is the problem in the story?
 - Based on what you have read, what can you infer will happen next?
- After reading the story - check for understanding
 - Who is the main character in this story? Was there more than one?
 - Did the problem get resolved? Why do you think the author did not fix the problem in this story?
 - If the story continued what do you think would happen next?
