Requirements/Objectives:

Pay: Up to \$35 an hour.

Driving: The position requires you to drive a company vehicle and is contingent on you being added to our insurance.

- Background in landscaping, forestry, horticulture, and/or climbing
- Pesticide and related licenses and certificates
- Experience in tree climbing safety- Aerial Rescue Training, CPR, etc.

Skills:

- Professional competency as a climbing Arborist to safely perform and lead tree care duties including pruning, removing and various technical services
- Communication: able to effectively communicate with a small team and provide constructive feedback to coworkers. Clearly communicate with clients and community members to answer technical and service related questions.
- Training: Ability to demonstrate and transfer technical skills to team members
- Able to work outside year round performing tree care services
- Knowledgeable in tree climbing safety- Aerial Rescue Training, CPR, etc.

Proficiency: Growth goals and corresponding wage adjustments will be outlined as you progress in these areas to build your proficiency.

Benefits:
