Specials	<p>At Home PE Assignments/ Week of 3/30-4/3 Grades 3-5: Log on to NowWeMove.com. Locate the Movement Pill exercises. Choose 2 exercises a day and perform them 3 times each. Grades K/1: Indoor obstacle course. Move around light furniture and household items to make a course. Have your student/students go through the course utilizing different movement skills. ex) 1 ft hop, 2 ft hop, crawl, skip, or gallop Time your student through the course and have them try to beat their previous best. This activity also works outside on a nice day. Grades K-5: Freeze dance- Put on some good tunes and dance vigorously. Whenever the music stops, the student must freeze in that position. Add in exercises to the music: ex) jumping jacks, run in place, push ups, sit ups, and the running man. Continue to go for brisk walks or runs, bike or scooter rides, shooting hoops, kicking around the soccer ball, or playing tag games with your family. Exercise for a minimum of 30 minutes daily.</p> <p>At Home PE Assignments/ Week of 4/6-4/9 Grades 3-5: Go to the pcentral website and find the “UNO” Fitness activity. Easy to create cards for this game if uno cards are not available. Grades K-2: Go to the pcentral website and find the activity “Follow the Leader Locomotors” This activity will teach your student the difference between locomotor and non locomotor movements. It will also review the difference between personal and general space. (Video for this activity is great) Grades K-5: Partner Throwing: Get a family member and any kind of ball. Practice partner toss. Adjust distance for success. You may throw underhand or over. Review Freeze Dance and other anytime activities above</p>
