Chelsea 2020 fourth 'Cup' kit

The kit celebrates the 50th anniversary of Chelsea's 1970 FA Cup victory. It was worn in this season's Third Round tie against Nottingham Forest (which Chelsea won 2-0) and may be worn in subsequent rounds of the 2019-20 FA Cup.

Euro 2020 Kit Update

Nike shirt images now emerging, all featuring a 'lightning bolt' flash down the sides of the shirts and multi-line trim on the cuffs.

Portugal will have green shorts on the home kit for the first time since 2004.

- England will have a blue away kit, produced by Nike. The shirt looks like it will have a polo shirt-style collar and red detailing. (Release date: March 2020)
- Belgium's away kit (by Adidas) will feature a white shirt with grey shorts and socks (released in March 2020)
- No details are known about the France kits, except that the away kit will be white
- Puma's away kit for Czech Republic will be coloured entirely in volt (lime green/yellow) with black trim (see below)
- Germany's away shirt by Adidas will be black with 'carbon grey' detailing and red/yellow cuffs. The rest of the kit is also black.

- Puma's Italy away shirt is white with navy trim as well as an ornate pattern in pale grey based on a series of chevrons
- Portugal's away shirt looks set to feature a paler version of the teal colour used by Portugal in recent seasons
- Spain's away shirt should be white with grey trim and some red detailing, as made by Adidas
- Switzerland's home shirt by Puma looks like it will be a darker shade of red with some white horizontal bands made up of white Swiss crosses, according to reports from FootyHeadlines. The away shirt is white with dark red trim around the neck, but the body of the shirt features a series of coloured mountain peaks in four different colours to represent the four languages of Switzerland. Each peak stripe is again made up of small Swiss crosses.
