## **Finger/Hand Mass Excision**

## **Post-Operative Protocol**

Day 0-10	<ul> <li>Keep dressing dry and intact, elevate hand</li> <li>No lifting greater than 5 pounds</li> <li>May do self-care activities as well as light duty work such as typing and writing at home</li> <li>Postoperative Day 3         <ul> <li>3 days after finger/hand masses removed dressings at thome, start gentle motion keep wound dry and covered with a bandaid</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Follow-up visit (Day 10)	<ul> <li>Incision site is checked by Dr. Twu's team</li> <li>Sutures removed, steri-strips placed if needed</li> <li>Incision can get wet</li> <li>May gradually return to activities with no weight restrictions</li> <li>Start Occupational therapy for scar massage for 2-4 weeks</li> </ul>
