PLEASE NOTE:

Entry of Events

1. Ages are calculated as of December 31st, 2026. Whichever age you turn in 2026 is the age group you will be competing in.
2. Each DISTRICT may nominate two competitors for each individual event and one team for each relay event.
3. A child is permitted to enter a maximum of two individual events, one freestyle relay and one Open Medley Relay.
4. No child may enter the same event in two different age groups.
5. A child must have competed at district level to compete at division. No invitationals allowed.

Progression

6. The 1st and 2nd place finishers from all individual Division Finals and the 1st placed team for all relay finals will proceed to the Western Metropolitan Regional Swimming Championships (date and venue above).
7. This meet will be conducted under Swimming Victoria guidelines along with policies and procedures of School Sport Victoria. Swimming Victoria officials will be in attendance on the day.
8. Swimming Victoria officials will have the final say when it comes to competitors' technique and disqualifications. Competitors who **DO NOT** show the correct technique will be disqualified (DQ) at Division level.

General

9. First Aid: All schools are to provide their own First Aid needs, support will be provided if needed.
10. Children are asked to stay in their district's swimming area behind the concrete while not swimming. No swimming in the indoor pool unless supervised by their parent.
11. We kindly ask that individuals stay off the concreted area surrounding the pool.
12. We appreciate your positivity towards the staff and volunteers who allow this day to occur.

Photography

13. Video and photographs are not allowed in the field of play, being the pool.

<u>Photography:</u>	Photography taken by spectators is permitted away from the area of competition. During SSV sporting events, SSV staff may photograph, film or record students participating in SSV activities or events. We do this for many reasons including to celebrate student participation and achievement, communicate with our parents and school community and to promote SSV events on the SSV website and other social and digital media accounts. It is the responsibility of the parent/carer and/or schools to inform SSV and/or the photographer which students should not be photographed. This can occur before an event or during an event. To opt-out of photography during an event please inform SSV staff and photographers at the event.
