MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 14TH JULY 2014

Attending were:

There were no apologies.

The Chairman welcomed Alison Hydon to the meeting and proposed that she be adopted onto the Council. All agreed.

The minutes that had previously been circulated were approved by all councillors and signed.

Matters Arising

A quote had been received for replacement notice boards from Moorland Joinery at £435 + VAT.

This was proposed by Cllr Drysdale and seconded by Cllr Pascoe, all approved.

There was formal approval for the toilet in the Mellowmead field from all cllrs.

A tender for tree maintenance would be drafted soon.

Working party. Volunteers and DNP rangers had now cleared Manaton Rocks path.

Sign replacement. The chairman to inform DNP of the location of a number of signs that had disappeared or become decayed.

Planning

There were no new applications in the Parish

An application regarding Trendlebeer had been turned down but will there is to be an appeal.

Highways

There was still water leaking outside Freelands. Also a leak in the Council field. Cllr Eveleigh had contacted the Water Board to fix this.. There was a split pipe at the sewage works.

Assets

Mellowmead, some fencing posts need attention. New swing seats had arrived, some more parts will be needed to fix them.

Village Hall, More repair works will be needed; lining the ceiling, lighting, floor, and consideration regarding disabled toilets.

Cllr Eveleigh has cleared the bank opposite Mellowmead to improve visibility and sought approval to remove a tree.

Visitors to Mellowmead field were still allowing dogs to field. There was no dog bin, could one be supplied and would TDC empty it. The Clerk to inquire and report. Also TDC does not empty the bottom bus shelter bin.

A working party will be needed in the Autumn.

Cllr Drysdale needs to update the Messenger delivery list. Cllr Hydon will take on Ex Cllr Everitt Wright's delivery round.

Cllr Rogers will preserve the playground woodwork.

C Cllr Gribble stated that due to financial constraints Rural Aid grants may be restricted.

Cllrs should consider their positions with regard to next May elections.
