OPENING HOURS

The venue will be open at the following times, please do not arrive earlier than this. 30min has been allotted for arrival and you will not be allowed into the venue beforehand:

WHAT TO DO ON ARRIVAL

We do not issue physical or digital tickets in advance of the event. On arrival at the event you should proceed directly to your round one table. We always appreciate meeting you all too, so come say hi at the TO desk / bar if you would like.

BAR

The venue is licensed and there will be a bar at the venue serving Alcoholic and soft beverages. As a result it is not permitted to bring outside alcoholic beverages into the venue and anyone doing so will be asked to leave.

The Bar will accept Cash and card payments.

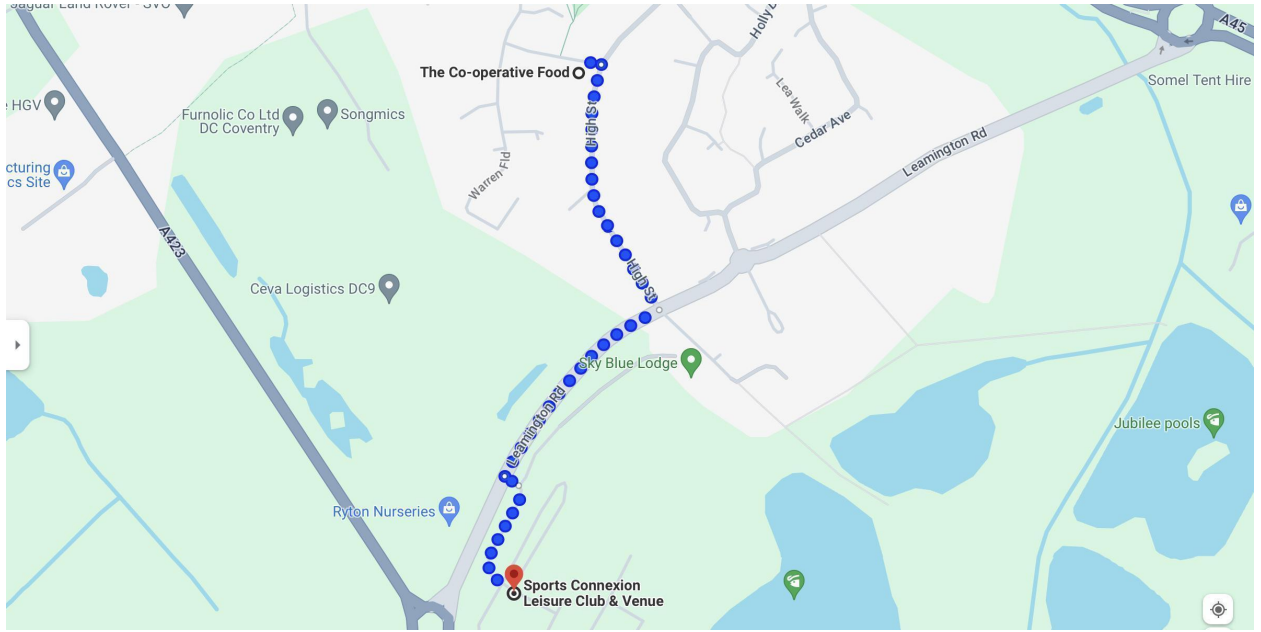
The Bar will be open for the duration of the event and will close 20:30 Saturday and 16:30 on Sunday.

FOOD

There are multiple food choices for an attendee at the Coventry GT. There will be 3 Food trucks available on site at the venue which will be located on the apron between the car park and the venue itself.

Should attendees not want to use the food trucks there is a local Co-operative convenience store located 0.5 miles from the venue in Ryton in Dunsmore which is approximately a 2 min drive or a 10 min walk.

Address: Leamington Rd, Ryton on Dunsmore, Coventry, CV8 3FL

Travelling south from M1

1. From M1 use M69 Birmingham/M6/Coventry.
2. Continue on to Coventry Eastern Bypass/A46
3. At Tollbar end transition to London Rd A45
4. Then follow slip road A423 to Southham and follow oxford road.
5. Take Leamington Rd turn off to A445
6. The venue will be on your right.



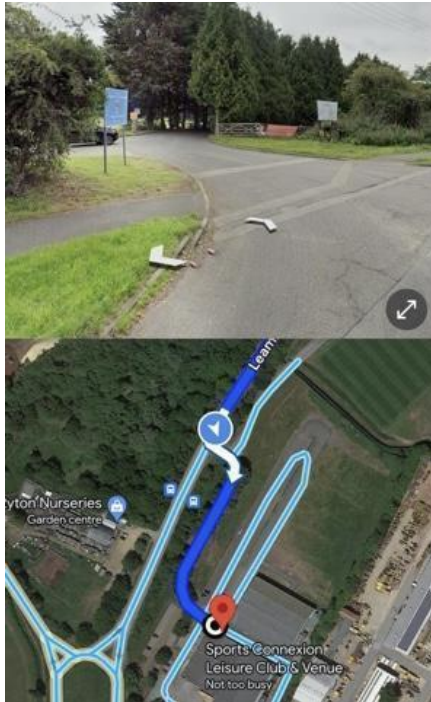


1. Exit M40 at junction 11 and take the A422 to Banbury.
2. Follow A422 to Hennef and exit to southam rd A423
3. follow 423 and then take 3rd exit at roundabout onto Leamington rd A445
4. Venue will be on your Right.



Travelling West from M6.

1. From A14 take A46 toward Rugby.
2. Stay on A426 until Newbold Road and then take first exit onto A4071
3. Merge onto London Rd A45.
4. Stay on A45 until Leamington rd then turn left onto A445.
5. The Venue will be on your left.



PARKING

There is substantial on-site parking available at the venue. The Parking area will open at 0845 and then will be locked when the venue closes at 2200. Access to the car park will not be available after this time.

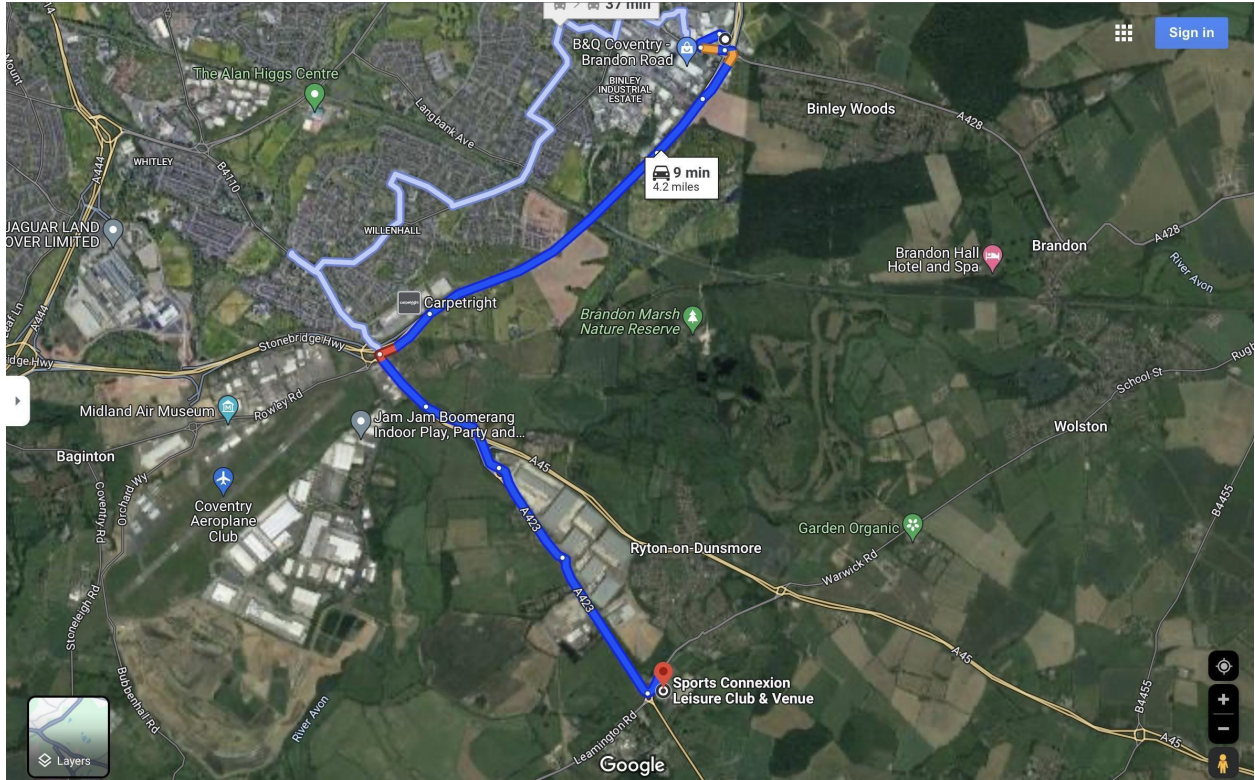

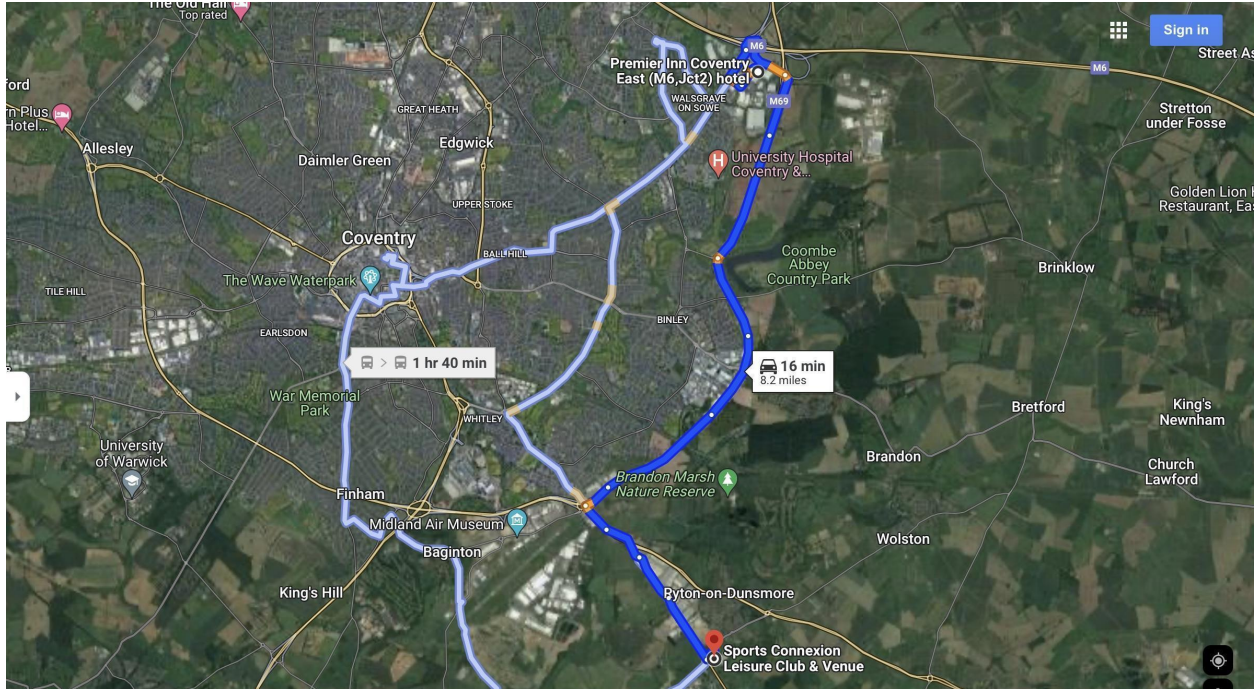
Hotels.

There are a number of hotels within 20 minutes of the venue.

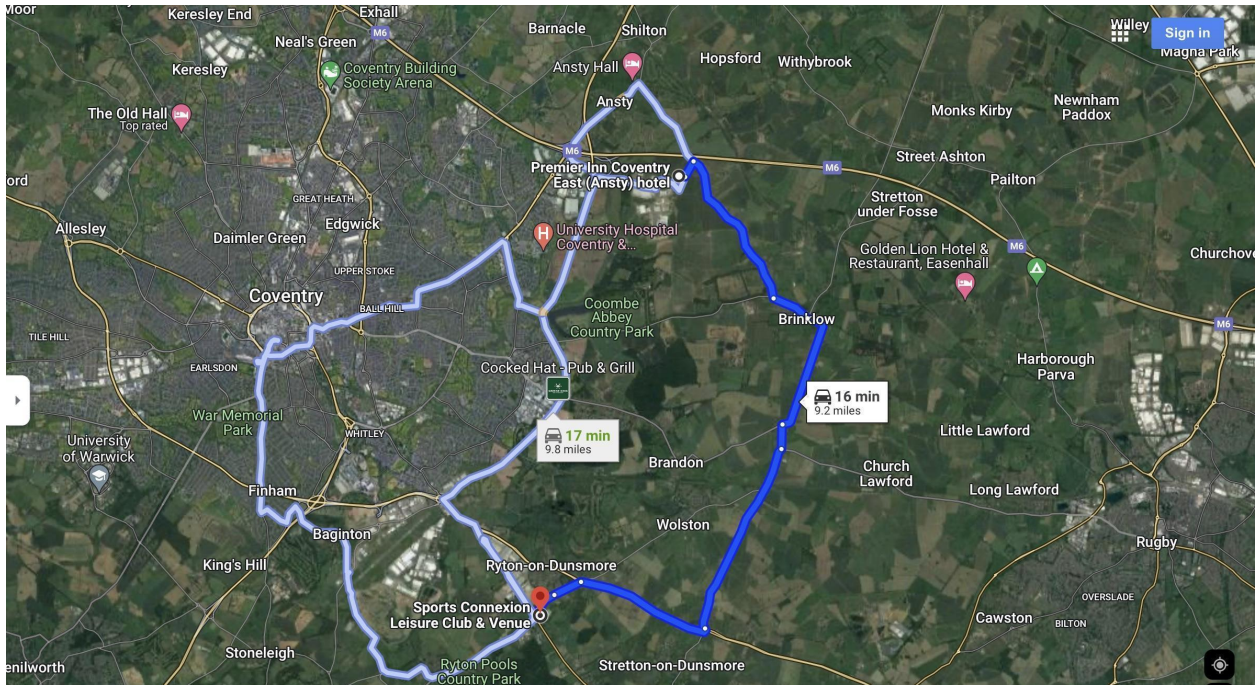
Premier Inn Coventry East Binley A46 - 9 Minutes



Premier Inn, Coventry East (M6,Jct2). - 16 min



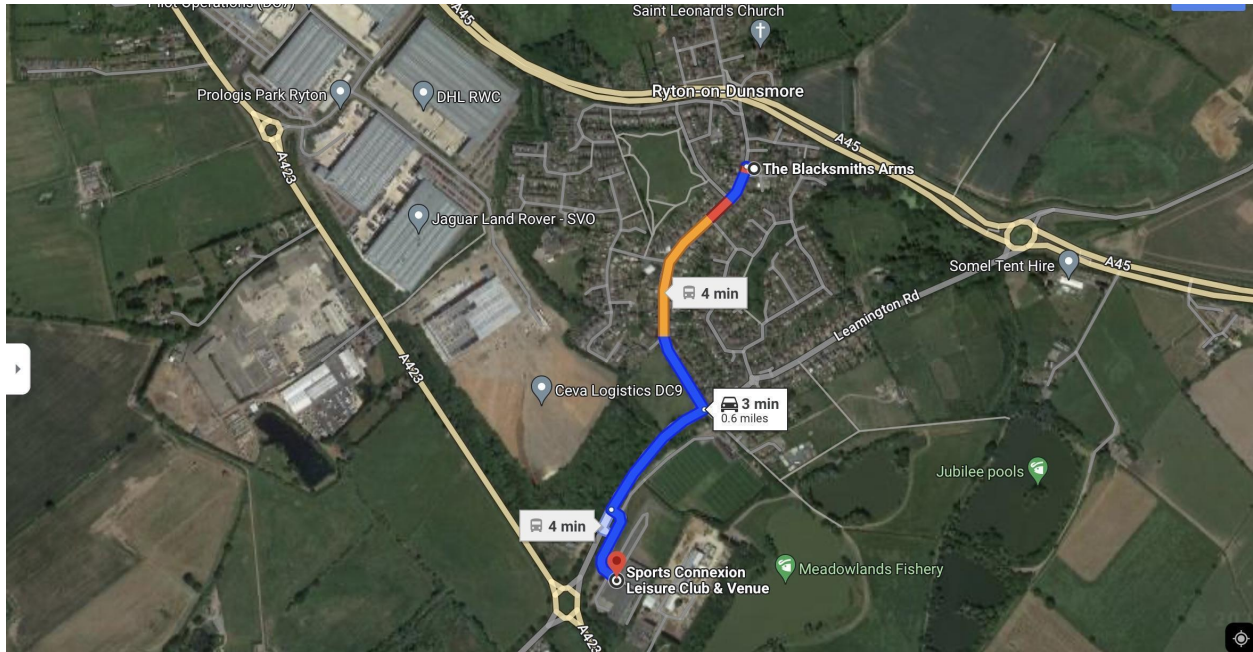
Premier Inn, Coventry East (Antsy). - 16 min



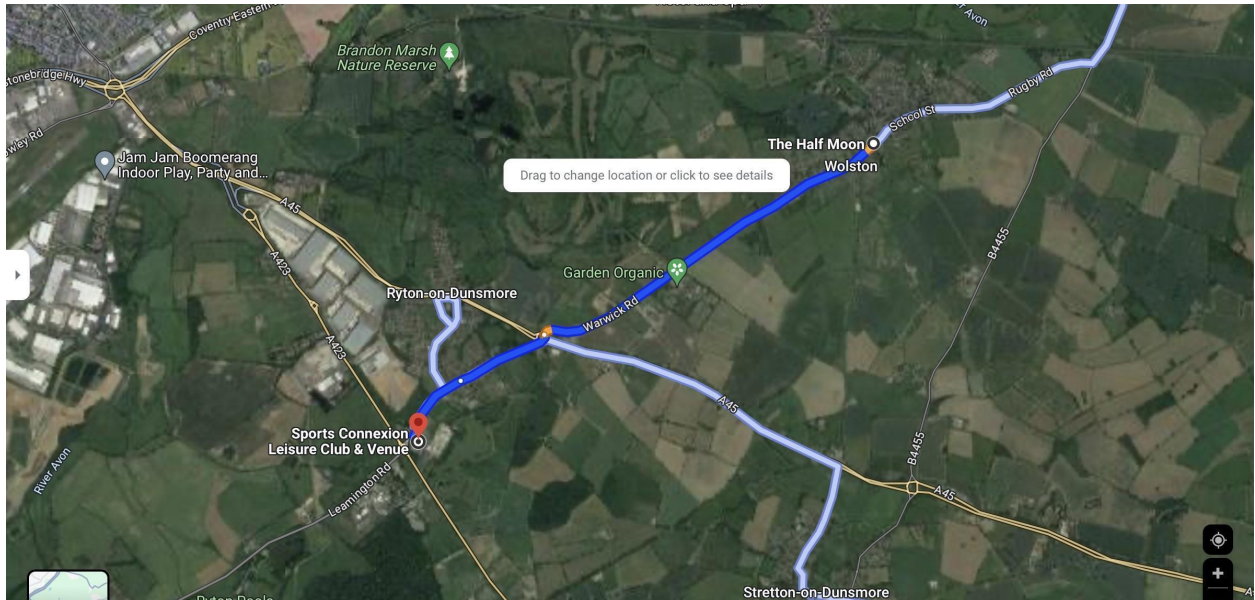
Restaurants.
