WHY CITIZEN CAMPAIGN CALLS?

Please join us for the first CITIZEN CAMPAIGN CALL, becoming a part of a network of Americans who are doing more than just supporting the "Marianne Williamson for President" campaign. Together we are creating a great American course-correction, and putting our democracy back on track.

Part education, part meeting with Marianne, part community-building, part interview with issues experts, part civic engagement, part way to find out what's happening with the campaign - these calls are more than dialogue. They are an opportunity to accept the responsibility of what it means to be an American citizen - to strengthen and defend our democracy as a core value and priority of our daily lives and our purpose on this planet. Are you ready to do your part?

Join us for the first CITIZEN CAMPAIGN CALL on Wednesday, February 13th when Marianne will lay out the plan by which we're going to impact the fabric of American democracy one gathering at a time... from Savannah to Taos, Winston-Salem to Manchester, Sioux City to Los Angeles, American citizens are ready to rise up. This is our time.

You can tune in on your own, invite a few friends over to watch with you, or plan a big event and jump start your local CITIZEN GROUP.

We've put together this **organizing guide** to give you some ideas for how to use these CITIZEN CAMPAIGN CALLS to further your civic engagement in your community. This guide includes ideas for how to use these CITIZEN CAMPAIGN CALLS as an organizing tool - to build both the campaign AND your citizenship muscles in an ongoing way- changing our political system on local, state and federal levels.

Below are instructions and guidance on how to host and structure your get togethers. You might choose to form a book club, create a safe space in which to learn about historical or current issues, and/or how to turn your group into a political activist group.

HOW DO I WATCH OR LISTEN TO THE CITIZEN CAMPAIGN CALLS?

These twice a month video calls will be hosted on Zoom, an online meeting tool. You can watch on your computer or phone, or just call in to hear the audio. All of the calls will be recorded and put on our YouTube page so that you can watch them later if you are unable to join us live. Generally, the calls will be about 30 - 45 minutes of Marianne speaking about different topics, or interviewing issue experts, and then live Q & A.

We're offering you the opportunity to get together with others who are interested in deepening their participation in civic society, reclaiming what the word "citizen" means in the 21st century. Engaging in restoring and strengthening our democracy can take two forms:

HOSTING A BOOK & DOCUMENTARY CLUB

Host a regular book club with others who are interested in engaging in this CITIZEN ACTIVISM in your area. Start with Marianne's book, *Healing the Soul of America*, or *Democracy In Chains: The Deep History of the Radical Right's Stealth Plan for America* by Nancy MacLean; *On Tyranny* by Timothy D. Snyder or *Fascism: A Warning* by Madeleine Albright.
