Healing Seminar 3. Dan Mohler

God's promises of healing and forgiveness are activated through faith in Jesus, emphasizing the importance of understanding His love and taking responsibility to overcome doubt and condemnation.

 - Forgiveness and healing are interconnected, as being forgiven leads to healing and vice versa, emphasizing the importance of understanding God's love and taking responsibility for one's actions.
 - Mercy overcomes judgment, and individuals should not feel undeserving of healing due to past actions.
 - Dan outlines a plan to receive support from the congregation for his journey to Macedonia and back to Judea, emphasizing the importance of their empowerment in his mission.

 - Yes and no cannot coexist; God's promises are unequivocally yes, especially regarding healing, and any doubt is a tactic of the enemy.

 - God's promises of healing are affirmed in His word, requiring our faith and agreement to activate His power.
 - We often pray for healing instead of exercising authority and making direct declarations to address our problems.
 - The Mount of Transfiguration signifies the transition to a new covenant of love through Jesus, emphasizing that all law and prophets are fulfilled in Him.
 - A man sought help for his son suffering from a spirit of infirmity, highlighting the need for faith and the power of God's presence in healing.
 - A young boy, struggling with his emotions, physically attacked Dan, who responded with love and patience, ultimately leading to a transformation in the boy's behavior.

 - Fasting and prayer are essential for overcoming unbelief and corrupted thinking, not for casting out spirits.
 - Healing is accessible to all believers who see as Jesus sees, empowering them to command ailments to leave in His name.
 - Belief in God's will empowers believers to overcome obstacles and manifest His presence in their lives.
 - After getting saved, I began witnessing car accidents in real time, experiencing the chaos and urgency firsthand.

 - Many people have internal health issues that cannot be easily identified or confirmed through external examinations.

Effective Prayer Techniques

 **Q:** What's the recommended method for praying healing?

A: Follow Jesus' **example** by making **direct declarations** to the problem, such as "stretch forth your hand" or "take your bed, walk,"

† **Q:** How are forgiveness and healing connected in scripture?

A: They are "**married together**" throughout scripture; when people feel **uncondemned** with a clear conscience, they can more easily **receive healing**.

 **Q:** What's the key focus when praying for healing?

A: Concentrate on **faith in Jesus' finished work**, not on healing through your own prayer; you're simply **representing that finished work**.

Practical Approach to Healing Prayer

 **Q:** Should one wait for symptoms before praying for healing?

A: No, be **proactive** and pray as soon as you hear about a condition, even if it's not yet symptomatic.

 **Q:** How assertive should one be when offering to pray for someone?

A: Be **aggressive** and **straightforward** in asking to pray, as people often don't expect to be healed and are not let down if they're not.

Mindset for Effective Prayer

🧠 **Q:** What mental approach should be avoided when praying for healing?

A: Avoid getting **self-focused** or **self-conscious** about praying right, powerful, or anointed; healing is in Jesus' finished work, not your prayer.

♥ **Q:** How important is God's love in healing?

A: Don't **underestimate the power of God's love**; He can still love and heal someone even if they speak negatively about Him.

Overcoming Doubts and Fears

🚫 **Q:** What should one not worry about when praying for healing?

A: Don't worry about **misrepresenting the gospel** if someone isn't healed, as most people don't expect to be healed anyway.

🧠 **Q:** What mindset hinders effective prayer?

A: Praying in a "**hope so**" manner, saying "maybe he will, maybe he won't," has nothing to do with the word, which says every promise is "**yes and amen**".

👁 **Q:** How should one view potential negative outcomes?

A: Don't think about **what could go wrong** or what might happen if they're not healed; instead, focus on **what could go right** and the goodness of God.
