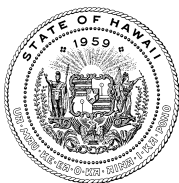

2. Board member Adriel Lam wants the government to more regularly maintain public natural spaces like highway medians and streams.

This is a two-part answer.

- There is no single owner of lands; it might be the city, the state, the federal government, or a private owner (ie: stream banks are maintained by the owner or by a joint maintenance agreement.)

One can search the City and County of Honolulu Real Property Assessment Division's web page

(<https://qpublic.schneidercorp.com/Application.aspx?AppID=1045&LayerID=23342&PageTypeID=2&PageID=9744&KeyValue=980370210000>) to see who owns the property. Please note that these maps are not intended for legal uses.

When you find the owner of the property, you can report the issue. The state and county have emails and contact numbers to report public right-of-way and roadside maintenance issues.

- Additionally, I have noted Member Lam's concerns and shared it with the largest state landowners – the Department of Transportation and the Department of Land and Natural Resources.

3. Board member Donald Sakamoto asked for an update on the Kaneohe Public Library.

The library's website now says, "We continue to renovate the Kāne'ohe Public Library, but will re-open for limited services starting Sunday, May 17, 2026. Hours will return to their previous schedule and posted on our website. Stay tuned for a celebration when renovations are completed!"

It also e-blasted people on its mailing list on May 13, 2026 with that update.

The outstanding issues from the construction team at the Department of Accounting and General Services (DAGS) are:

- The HSPLS added to the original work order with a request to lay steel plates over a drainage swale in the parking lot so people don't accidentally trip into it. Funding for the extra work has been identified and is in the process of approval to permit a change order to be issued. The estimated construction completion time is the end of July, assuming funding is in place by June.
- Library staff noticed an odor in the lower-level meeting room. DAGS' construction team has not yet been able to identify the source, but the remainder of the library is odor-free. DAGS continues to investigate the source of the odor and is working with the library to resolve the issue.
