What insurances are accepted? Can they diagnose impetigo? Rashes? Ear infections? Cultures? Mental health aspect of GSH? Standing orders on Medications - Dr. McNeil is working with Region 3 to provide standing orders for the districts to provide things such as calamine, neosporin, benadryl cream, epi-pens, narcan, etc. - all members present agreed parents would need to sign a form that they are okay with these medications being administered Kinsa thermometers - we still have a surplus remaining to pass out - any ideas what to do with thermometers welcome
