Examination Committee

(theoretical and practical)

The regular annual Astronomy Olympiad consists of three rounds with the aim to select the top 5 students for IOAA and similar competitions. There are going to be theoretical and practical exams. The Exam Committee is mainly responsible for selecting the IOAA syllabus to be used for the exams, writing the exams and correcting them.

First round - Regional round:

- One Theoretical exam that is done online from home.
- Consist of multiple-choice questions covering parts of the syllabus suggested by IOAA.

Second round - National round:

- Theoretical and practical exams.
- If possible, the exam of the second round is to be written in person.
- The practical part could be done with telescopes or using computer simulations and other experiments.
- Top 15 students will qualify for the next final round.

Third round - Final round:

- Selection examinations will try to cover most of the syllabus suggested by IOAA.
- Practical exams are done with telescopes in a manner similar to the real settings in IOAA.
- Selection of the top5 students to represent Switzerland in IOAA.

Other Tasks involve:

- Keep grading in mind, make the solutions to the questions easy to grade.
- Write a detailed correction manual (including how many partial points to give).
- Correct exams after each round.
- Prepare exams feedback to be sent back to students after correction.

Training Committee

(theoretical and practical)

After each examination round there are going to be practical and theoretical training periods. The Training committee is responsible to prepare, organize, teach, and implement those training sessions.

Tasks involve:

- Prepare and implement training material (Scripts, Presentations, Exercise Sheets)
- Think about training locations and logistics
- Prepare and coordinate practical Exams with Telescopes.
- Communicate with Exams team for prerequisites
- Prepare the selected swiss delegation for IOAA.

Translation Committee

(EN, DE, FR, IT)

* Tasks involve:

- Interface with all of the three committees.
- Translate information and exams to the national swiss languages and English.
- Ensure accuracy and reliability of the content.
