Water

The Corpus Christi Mayor announced a water boil notice in Corpus Christi Tuesday afternoon for the Corpus Christi area due to low water pressure from a break in the CC Water Distribution System. The City of Corpus Christi is issuing this Boil Water Notice as a precautionary measure as we work to restore conditions post severe winter weather event.
