

SCHOOL BUS PASSENGER RULES

1. Follow the driver's directions the first time they are given.
2. Go directly to an available or assigned seat.
3. Remain seated and facing forward at all times – keep the aisle clear.
4. Exhibit classroom conduct at all times.
5. No throwing objects on, from, or into the bus.
6. Be courteous. No swearing, profane language, or obscene gestures.
7. Respect the rights and safety of others.
8. No weapons, hazardous materials, tobacco products, alcohol, drugs, nuisance items or animals are allowed on the bus.
9. Keep head, hands and feet inside the bus.
10. Cross the road or street in front of the bus only after the buses come to a complete stop and upon direction of the driver.

THE DRIVER IS AUTHORIZED TO ASSIGN SEATS, AND STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO COMPLY WITH DRIVERS INSTRUCTIONS.

Students not complying with the passenger rules are subject to suspension of their bus riding privileges. School buses are equipped with video/audio camera monitoring devices, and all students riding buses are subject to video/audio monitoring. To protect the privacy of students the video/audio tapes are available only to school administrators. If your student has a problem on the bus, please call the Transportation Office at 662-7643 immediately. It is impossible to investigate incidents if they are not reported in a timely manner.
