## MILWAUKEE MAN DIES AT THE HOME OF HIS MOTHER IN THIS CITY

Martin J. Jansen, Milwaukee, died about 9:30 o'clock this morning at the home of his mother, Mrs. Margaret Jansen, 43 Central avenue, after an illness of several months. Mr. Jansen was a native resident of Oshkosh and had lived here all his life until 1920.

He underwent an operation for the removal of a goiter at a Milwaukee hospital in June, 1930, from which it is said he never fully recovered. Early in August he sustained a heart attack, remained in a hospital there for some time, and had spent the last eight weeks in bed at his boyhood home.

His death occurred on his birthday. He was born here Dec. 1, 1886.

After completing his school life as a graduate of Oshkosh High school with the class of 1907, Mr. Jansen entered the office of the Morgan company of this city and advanced to the position of an estimator before the world war, during which he served 10 months at the Great Lakes naval training station near Chicago. He was retired as a reserve petty officer.

After the war he again worked for the Morgan concern, but in 1920 went to Milwaukee, becoming an estimator for the Interior Woodwork company.

The survivors, besides his mother, are two sisters, Miss Alice M. Jansen, Oshkosh, and Mrs. J. W. Dickinson, of Providence, R. I., and a brother, Herbert D. Jansen, of Milwaukee. His father, Herbert Jansen, worked in the mechanical department of The Northwestern for many years before his death in August, 1928.
