



**I. Senate Committee Reports:**

**A. Academic Affairs:** We will be working on getting TV monitors installed in each of the academic buildings as an additional way for not only SGA, but the colleges, to advertise relevant information to their students. We will be working on reaching out to the Deans and faculty of each of the colleges to determine where they think the best area to install these would be, and then getting into contact with university facilities to get a quote for the procurement and installation of the TVs. Next, we are working on compiling feedback from constituents we have heard from events and throughout the semester to go to the Deans with and work with them to find solutions. If there is anything you have heard or want to make sure that we include, please reach out to me, or your respective college senators. Finally, we are also beginning to work on creating a master study space map that will lay out all the different study spaces on campus. **B. Appropriations:** We are planning our outreach event to be on 11/29 at either 7 or 8 pm. The event will be targeted at club members interested in learning more about the grant process for their clubs, but all will be welcome. Food will be catered. **C. Diversity, Equity, and Student Belonging:** The Committee voted on the BSU grant proposal and determined that their request does not qualify to be a DESB grant (refer to meeting minutes for vote breakdown). The justification is that this grant proposal is more suited to be a general grant rather than a DESB grant, especially due to a lack of clarity in terms of how BSU plans on using these funds to promote DEI work/events on campus.

Prior to Tuesday 11/16, we had 4 panelists on board for our Pizza with the (Diversity) Panel Community Outreach Event. Rev. Daniel Meyers suggested some more names, and we reached out to them as well. As of Wednesday 11/17, we have 8 panelists who accepted the invite and plan on attending the outreach event.
