

CHARMELLE PARK HOURS AND PROGRAMS

The park is open to the public 7 days a week from 8 am to dusk. The Nature Center is open on Saturday and Sunday for cars to park at Charmelle. The permit box is at the entrance to the parking lot. There are public restrooms and a water fountain located next to the parking lot.

In the event of an emergency or start is not at the park, please dial 911.

After you hike, please stop by our Nature Center to view our educational displays and find out about the programs we offer here.

Fall Moon Hikes: offered every month on the full moon. Moderate hikes out to bluff and back.

Other Programs: Bug nights, Withdrawer Hikes, astrophotography nights and more. Withdrawer Hikes, held out under programs are coming up. Please call 310-347-4384 to reserve your spot.

THIS IS A WILDERNESS PARK

You are a welcomed visitor, but please remember that Charmelle is home to many wonderful native animals and plants that can be potential hazards. Please be aware that rattlesnakes, mountain lions and ticks are out there. If you choose to hike in this area, there is also poison oak throughout the park. You must leave responsible and be courteous every step of the way.

OUR BASIC RULES:

- Stay on the designated trails
- Dogs must be on a leash at all times
- No off-road motorized vehicles allowed
- Weapons are not allowed anywhere
- Open flames are allowed anywhere
- No open fires, BBQ's, smoking or litter behind
- Do not remove plants or animals
- Do not litter
- Respect all
