From the Desk of the Superintendent

<u>Check-In Survey</u> - We have completed over twenty instructional days of the 2020-21 school year and we are incredibly proud of what we have collectively accomplished. As we plan for our phased-in return to full in-person instruction, we would like to provide parents, staff, and students the opportunity to reflect on our first 20 days and plan for our phased-in return using this <u>survey</u>.

Equity Presentation: On **October 15** @ **6:30 pm** via <u>Zoom webinar</u>, Dr. Howard Stevenson will discuss how racial stress and racial trauma can affect every stage of life. His work focuses on how educators, community leaders, students, and parents can emotionally resolve face-to-face, racially stressful encounters that reflect racial profiling in public spaces, fuel social conflicts in neighborhoods, and undermine our emotional well-being.

<u>Election Day Reminder</u>: Governor Murphy has mandated that all New Jersey Schools will be closed to in-person instruction on **November 3, Election Day**. This day will be a remote learning day for all HVRSD students.
