  - o Ripple Effect group called "Tree"

### VP Update

- Distance learning VP for Gr 5 & 6 with 2K students.
- Building, maintaining, solidifying, and re-building relationships to bring everyone back together has been the efforts for September
- o Trying to understand the assessed levels of all learners—key focus of Sept.
  - Strengths and understanding next steps
- Orange Shirt Day
  - Challenging topic with new learning at all age levels
  - This is not a celebration but rather a recognition of Indigenous experience within residential schools
- Entry and Exit Procedures
  - Adhering to protocols is key to safety of children

- Key to helping kids develop a 6ft benchmark in their minds
- Kids have really adapted to the distance markers
- Dots are their "Safe Place", and kids just seem to know to go there during incidents

# Outdoor Learning Time

- Deviation from regular/pre covid experience
- Had to look at alternatives to outdoor time because what was offered wasn't feeling safe for individuals within the building
- Provides a much-needed balance throughout the day
- Seems to be going quite well
- Gives kids more of an opportunity to work as a team or cohort and they can easier recognize kids who may need an invite to play or may need some additional emotional interaction
- Laurier TEC (Teacher Education Candidates)
  - Once a week there are 3 that attend
  - Opportunity for them to learn the role and get to know teaching
  - They'll be there all year and gradually increase the amount of time they're able to teach within the school
  - Great opportunities for mentorship and leadership

## Principal Update

- Safety Measures

# Boundary Study

- Aniko and Rebecca will be representing
- First meeting in the next couple of weeks
- Looking at Tartan Ave School boundaries
- Janet Metcalf, Laurentian, Southwood, Jean Steckle, and others are involved
- Want to ensure we're expanding as needed to avoid portables and providing a safe space for students
- Over 100 requests for additional families to attend at Jean Steckle resulting in 850-900 students if they were to be added. Space is at a premium
- Currently there are 710 students with additional housing opening up
- Ideally the number would be 600 including remote where if they were to come back, they'd be adding 60 students

    - Parents are afraid they're going to be tricked into roles
    - Worried they're going to have to volunteer
    - Some work 2-3 jobs
    - Some have additional commitments
  - o Could we create additional "Advertisement" re: council meetings to help engage parents
  - Could we do a google survey to get dates and times and provide further detail on what happens within the meetings
    - What does parent engagement look like?
  - Many parents are asking about why our board protocols are so different from the Catholic protocols
    - Catholic schools are doing pictures and parents are wondering why we aren't
    - Visitors are NOT allowed into the school
    - Different boards do things according to the direction of the public health units
    - All schools are given the same message and they implement them
    - Would need to ask trustees why we're so different from the catholic board when we all fall within the same health units
  - Rapid Testing—to be done based on what's the virus level of the area—if it comes back negative and they have symptoms how long do they have to stay home?
    - Should we message parents to remind them to have their kids tested

• Only do rapid tests when kids are asymptomatic
