Action Plan: What steps will be taken to achieve this goal?	Teacher Professional Learning, Data Analysis, and alignment and pacing guide with new reading program. (All Grades) 1. Individual teachers and grade level teams will review data to determine greatest need of focus. (instruction and intervention needs) 2. All teachers will study and become familiar with the new ELA standards and how the new reading curriculum aligns to the standards. 3. Teachers and Instructional Assistants will collaborate once a week to create and plan intervention lessons that are aligned to the skills the students are working to master. 4. Teachers will work with their teams to learn and study the new reading curriculum for implementation. 5. Teachers and instructional assistants will attend school-wide professional development monthly to discuss and analyze data and next steps for individual student success.

Action Plan: What steps will be taken to achieve this goal?	Instructional Coach at MES will support all teachers grades 4 - 5, Special Education, and other support staff assigned instructional roles: (1) Support teachers in daily rigorous Tier I literacy instruction through coaching cycles. (2) Develop increased capacity (through professional development, co-teaching opportunities, observation and feedback loops) to administer appropriate literacy assessments, analyze data to determine implications for instruction, set instructional goals, and provide effective Tier 1 instruction and targeted intervention. (3) Meet weekly with school grade-level PL30 teams analyzing Acadience Reading progress monitoring data, program data, digital data and classroom literacy assessment (specific to JSD grade-level identified Power Standards, Learning Targets, and Standards Indicators) to determine implications for instruction. (4) Provide ongoing training in effective literacy instruction, assessment and intervention practices for all teachers grades 4 - 5, Special Education, and other support staff assigned instructional roles.
