

استخدام وسائل التواصل الاجتماعي - Plural Adjectives

ADJECTIVES ARE STUPID CROWDFOLLOWING MORONS.

They just do whatever their noun is doing – including being plural.

المصريون الجيّدون

أصدقاء مختلفين

بنات جيّدات

This is why Munes describes his friends as أصدقائي المختلفين - the first word is definite because of the attached pronoun (MUNES' friends, not just any friends), so the adjective also has to be definite (using an الـ) and plural (adding an ين to it).

Plural adjectives are (usually) ون or ين for men or mixed men and women, and ات for women only.

Some adjectives take special forms describing humans, like جدد for the word جديد as in طلاب جدد (new students).

However, **When describing plural non-rational beings (NRB), aka non-humans:**

Think San Francisco... **Singular Feminine**

بيوت جميلة طاولات طويلة الولايات المتحدة مدن بعيدة فلوس كثيرة

We already know that adjectives have to match their nouns when they are singular:

بنت جميلة رجل جميل قهوة كبيرة كتاب كبير

RB or NRB is irrelevant. BUT it becomes relevant when we are talking about the plurals of these objects.
