Sex, health and relationships education is learning about the emotional, social and physical aspects of growing up, relationships, sex, human sexuality and sexual health. Some aspects are taught in science, and others are taught as part of personal, social, health and economic education (PSHE).

Our programme of RSHE provides accurate information about the body, reproduction, sex, health and sexual health. It also gives children and young people essential skills for building positive, enjoyable, respectful and non-exploitative relationships and staying safe both on and offline.

In Year 7 and 8 RSHE is taught through discrete lessons as part of the wider Personal Development programme. In Years 9 and 10 RSHE has its own half-termly focus and we ensure that all materials are age appropriate and quality assured. The resources are shared below for your knowledge and understanding.
