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	If unsure: Early voting makes voting easy, and is a great insurance policy in case you find yourself busy on election day, or are otherwise unable to make it to the polls
	If by mail: Great! Do you have an absentee ballot already? Have you turned it in?

Absentee Ballot FAQ

Please mark individuals who would like to vote early as App Requested. If people have already sent in an application, mark as App Collected. I will cut lists of people who have requested apps and get them to individuals in person or through mail.

I like to go to the polls	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If you don't turn in your ballot you can still vote in person on Election Day. Think of this as an insurance policy in case something stops you from voting on Election Day
Giving personal information	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We don't need much information, just the information that you would need to give to register to vote. We bring these forms directly to the Secretary of State. <p>You can also go to www.mnvotes.sos.state.mn.us and request an absentee ballot online</p>
I'm too busy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Give them the form and website. You can mail this form in and get a ballot in the mail, or go to the link and request on online.
