

Title Must Be Written in English Using Times New Roman 12 pt, 1 Space (No More Than 15 Words)

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ABSTRACT

Manuscript should be written in MS Word file. Abstract should be written in English, single space. Abstract is a summary that includes the background, objectives, methods, results and conclusion in a clear and concise form. Word count for abstract should be 200 - 250 words. Abstract should be written in 1 (one) paragraph.

Keywords: *Font type Times News Roman, size 10pt and number of keywords not more than 5 keywords.*

INTRODUCTION

The article consists of: **Introduction, Research Methods, Results and Discussion, Conclusions, References.** The manuscript is written on A4 paper (21 cm x 29.7 cm), with a mirror margin of 30 mm upper, bottom 25 mm, left (inside) 25 mm and right (outside) 20 mm. The content of the paper is written in Times New Roman letters measuring 12 pt with a distance of 1 space, and typed using MS Word. **The paper is written between 8-10 pages.**

RESEARCH METHODS

Articles are written in English. The writing in the main description uses the Times New Roman typeface size 12 pt, justified, 1 space, as in this document. Authors

are allowed to use other types of letters for special purposes, for example, to distinguish the source code of a computer program.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSIONS

Tables and pictures are placed in the center of the page. The title of the table is written on top of the table, while the title of the image below the image, both with Times New Roman 12 pt. The letters in the Table use Times New Roman 10 pt 1 space. If obtained from another source, the source of the table or figure is please listed. The table is depicted simply to avoid poor print. Each table and figure should be referenced in paragraphs. Tables and Figures are placed as close as possible to the description that refers to the first time. Generally, Tables and Figures are placed after they are mentioned in the description of the paper. The numbering of Tables and Figures is sorted from number 1 onwards. An example of a table can be seen in Table 1. The letters for the caption on the image should be large and clear enough that they are easy to read.

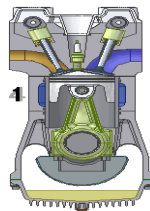


Figure 1. Font size 12

This acknowledgement is written under the conclusion, before the reference. In this *acknowledgement*, the main parties who support this research are mentioned, such as funders, agencies/data providers (can be disguised if anonymous is needed), research assistants.

REFERENCES

It is recommended to use a reference management application, such as MENDELEY. References are displayed at the end of the article using APA *style* format and are sorted alphabetically from the last name of the main author. The letters used are Times New Roman 12 pt, with *a* hanging format of 10 mm, as in the example below. The text or sentence in the subject that refers to the reference is marked with the last name of the author.

References must be in the form of published material and/or easily accessible information to the public. The order in which the reference is written is as follows.

Author's last name, first name initials. (Year of Publication). Book Title. Publisher Name, Published City.

Author's last name, first name initials. (Year of Publication). "Journal Article Title". Conference Name, Conference Venue, Conference Date, page number.

Author's last name, first name initials. (Year of Publication). Title of the journal article. *Journal Name, Journal Vol. Number* (Publication number), page number.

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
