Are You Interested in Research?

The brand new Undergraduate Research Opportunity Program (UROP) is an exciting opportunity for students to engage in research and mentorship opportunities with SJSU faculty in your discipline or project of interest.

Who Can Participate?

In this pilot year, UROP will be accepting first year students, second year students, and new transfer students from the following colleges:

- College of Social Science
- College of Humanities and Arts
- College of Education
- College of Health and Human Sciences
- Undecided with a non-STEM focus

What Is Expected Of Participants?

Students are expected to participate in the following:

- UROP Transformative Leadership Research Course (2 semesters)
- Work closely with faculty mentor on research project between 3-9 hours per week
- Attend 1:1 peer mentoring sessions
- Present research at spring research event

How Long Is The Program?

All participants are expected to participate in the program for the entire academic year (fall/spring). Students will be enrolled in the UROP course and participate in their research project each semester. It is expected that each student will be matched with a project by the end of October.

What Will I Receive?

All students accepted into UROP will receive graded course credit which can go to the Transformative Leadership minor in the College of Education, or elective credits toward your degree (depending on the degree requirements for your program). Students eligible for work-study through their financial aid package will be able to use their research experience as their work-study option and receive an hourly wage (still to be determined). Students will also receive peer mentoring support from trained Peer Connections student mentors.
