

THE COURSE WILL COVER:

- I. Personal development and discipleship
- II. Practical contemplative listening skills of the spiritual director
- III. Spiritual discernment and decision making
- IV. Basic understanding of human development and the recognition of different life transition stages on the way, to include specialist areas such as bereavement and loss; fear, anger and doubt; the dying; masculine/feminine spirituality
- V. Psycho-spiritual themes such as The Dark Night of the Soul and depression, patterns of spiritual growth, images of God and self, working with the Shadow in the spiritual life, and dreams
- VI. An experience of the ways of prayer developed from differing Christian traditions
- VII. Use of creative arts in spiritual directing
- VIII. Ethics and good practice involved in the process of spiritual directing

THE COURSE TEAM:

The ecumenical Gloucestershire spiritual direction course has been running for over 20 years. The current course team is drawn from a range of traditions including Quakerism, Church of England and Roman Catholicism, and guest speakers support the course from a wide variety of Christian backgrounds, traditions and professional experience.

- ❖ Have you felt that God may be calling you to 'companion' others in this way?
- ❖ Have you considered whether training might develop your gifts?

WHO?

The course is open to Christians of any denomination (clergy and lay). Those seeking a place should:

- ❖ Be someone who finds others turn naturally to them
- ❖ Be mature and stable in their Christian faith (this does not mean without questions and challenges!)
- ❖ Have a spiritual guide (we can help you find someone suitable if necessary)
- ❖ Have knowledge of the scriptures and traditions of Christianity

AIMS OF THE COURSE:

- ❖ To encourage giftedness and offer practical training in the skills and art of spiritual direction
- ❖ To nurture your own spiritual life
- ❖ To develop an appreciation and knowledge of the wide variety of Christian spiritualities
- ❖ To broaden understanding and experience of differing traditions of prayer

WHEN & HOW?

We are now running a 2 year 'blended' course to allow greater access to training. This consists of 2 semesters a year of teaching and experiential sessions on Zoom, with residential weekends and face to face workshop days.

Year 1:

Semester 1: Introductory Residential Weekend from late afternoon on the **19th January 2024** until after lunch on the **21st January**. The semester will then run on 6 Wednesdays from **7th February - 8th May**.

A **Workshop Day** in person on **June 5th**.

Semester 2: Residential Individually Guided Retreat **6th - 8th September**.

Then 6 Wednesdays on Zoom from **11th September – 6th November 2024**. **Workshop day** on **Nov 20th** completes the semester.

Year 2:

Semester 3: Residential workshop weekend: **February 7th - 9th 2025** then 6 Wednesdays on Zoom from **February 12th - May 7th**. A **Workshop Day** will follow on **Saturday June 7th**.

Semester 4: A workshop day on **September 10th** followed by 5 Wednesdays on Zoom from **September 24th – November 19th**.

The final course day will be on **December 3rd 2025**.

COST:

The fee for the course will be **£425** per semester. This includes the cost of the residential weekends and workshop days. Financial assistance may be available, but students are encouraged to explore potential funding from their spiritual community or church, charities that provide funding (we can advise) or an employer who supports the application.
