2. Inspiration:

- a. Inspire the next generation by exemplifying the positive values of sport and actively mentoring young people from diverse backgrounds to become community leaders and agents of change.
- b. Expand access to soccer and other sports programs and resources, particularly in underserved communities, to promote physical and mental health and support well-being for all.

3. Philanthropy:

- a. Establish and sustainably fund a non-profit arm dedicated to advancing our mission by strategically investing in initiatives that directly improve the lives of underserved communities in Chicagoland and create pathways for their engagement with Chicago House AC.
- b. Forge equitable and impactful partnerships with community-based organizations, particularly those serving marginalized populations, to amplify their work and provide meaningful opportunities for them through our platform and resources.

4. Service

- a. Implement a club-wide service initiative with a target of 1,000+ volunteer hours annually, focusing on projects that directly address community needs identified in partnership with local organizations. Develop a clear system for tracking service hours and recognizing the contributions of all participants, including players, staff, and dedicated volunteers.
- b. Cultivate inclusive and exceptional experiences for all fans, players, staff, partners, ensuring accessibility and responsiveness across all interactions, year-round.
- c. Proactively exceed the expectations of our diverse fan base and partners by fostering genuine engagement, actively seeking feedback, and demonstrating a deep understanding of their needs. Additionally, ensuring that the same continues with all new fans and partners.

5. Legacy:

- a. Advocate for and actively support the development of safe and accessible spaces for recreation, learning, and community building in underserved areas, prioritizing projects that promote inclusivity and equitable access.

- b. Serve as a consistent and influential advocate for positive social change in Chicagoland, leveraging our platform to raise awareness, challenge inequities, and inspire collective action.
