## **ABSTRACT 12pt, Times New Roman bold**

The abstract should be clear, concise, and descriptive. This abstract should provide a brief introduction to the problem, objective of the paper/presentation, followed by a summary of policy suggestions. The abstract should be **no more than 300 words (without reference), formatted in Word document, justified alignment, line spacing 1.5, using size 12 Times New Roman font**. The abstract should end with a comment on the significance of the policy or a brief conclusion. A list 3 - 5 keywords separated by semicolons (;), font italic, follows the abstract, as shown here.

## **Scope of the Forum Discussions or Presentations for the Abstract**

The discussion will explore a range of topics, including but not limited to :

1. generative AI policy in different HEI practices,
2. using AI for Language Translation and Localization in HEI,
3. delineating research writing policy in HEI,
4. establishing HEI course policies for writing with AI, and
5. evaluating student writing in an AI era, in HEI.

## **Presenter's Guideline**

1. Presenter has to register before submitting an abstract.
2. The abstract should be no more than 300 words.

3. The abstract should emphasize the background, objectives, case studies or stories illustrating the use of AI, and the AI policy recommendation derived from the case study.
4. Presenters should follow the abstract template provided (<https://its.id/AbstractTemplateAWCForum>) and submit it in doc. format.
5. Abstracts accepted for the discussion are scheduled for a 15 minute presentation.
6. Presenters will need to follow the presentation template for the parallel discussions. The presentation template can be downloaded in the following link (<https://its.id/PPTTemplateAWCForum>)
7. The presentation will emphasize the background, problem statement, literature review (optional), case studies or stories showcasing the utilization of AI in HEI, the AI policy recommendation, and conclusion.
8. There are no restrictions on the number of pages to be used for the presentation but presenters should make sure that it can be presented for a 15 minutes presentation.
