The 3B's Animation Performance Task

Introduction

- Day 1 Introduction and begin research into 3B's
 - Set up portfolio
 - Research possible animation topics to complete
 - Write <u>Artistic Intention</u>

- Day 2 Brainstorm and storyboard ideas on how you will tell your story
 - Storyboard ideas as needed
 - Begin using Paint to create a background
- Day 3 Finish creating background for your animation
- Day 4 Create any sprites (text, speech bubbles, thought clouds, etc) to help your animation
- Day 5 Finish creating sprites to help your animation
 - Begin animating in Pivot
- Day 6 & 7 Continue animating in Pivot
- Day 8 Finish animation
 - Use WeVideo to add title, sound, etc as needed
 - Finish animation & Insert animation into portfolio
 - PUBLISH

You should begin by reviewing the <u>3B's: Be Safe, Be Respectful & Be Responsible</u>. You have been provided some resources but you should use Google and YouTube to provide yourself additional information and ideas.
