## Kindergarten Registration Procedures

**\*\*\*Please note: Children must be 5 years old before September 1, 2025, to register for Kindergarten.\*\*\***

**Step 1:** This **must** be completed before proceeding to Step 2.

Complete the [New Student Registration](#) through the Sapphire Community Portal.

Please ensure that all applicable documents below are uploaded to your Online Registration Form prior to submitting. If you are unsure how to upload them to the Online Registration Form, you may email a copy to your child's school. (see links below)

### **Required Documents:**

- Original birth certificate (or proof of birthdate)
- 2 proofs of residency in Northampton Area School District that also verify parent/guardian name and address
  - One (1) of the following:
    - Copy of current mortgage, lease, or rental agreement, or
    - [Residency affidavit](#) or [Multiple Occupancy Certificate](#), and
  - At least one (1) of the following:
    - Current utility bill (within previous thirty (30) days), or
    - Pennsylvania Department of Transportation identification or driver's license, with current address, or
    - Copy of recent paycheck stub with name and address of employee and employer, or
    - Copy of state/federal program enrollment.
- Custody papers (if applicable)
- Immunization Record Must Show the Following:
  - 4 doses of tetanus, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis (1 dose on or after the 4th birthday)
  - 4 doses of polio (4th dose on or after the 4th birthday and at least 6 months after the previous dose given)
  - 2 doses of measles, mumps, rubella - usually given as MMR
  - 3 doses of hepatitis B
  - 2 doses of varicella (chickenpox) or evidence of immunity

If a child does not meet the basic requirements by the first day of school, the parent must submit a plan to the school district to have immunizations completed within 5 days. The school district will work with parents who submit plans for immunization. Please note that certified proof of immunization is required by STATE LAW and must be attained in order for children to continue in school.

Physical and dental examinations are required for entrance into kindergarten and may be completed up to one year prior to entrance into kindergarten. The [Physical Form](#) and [Dental Form](#) for examinations can also be found on our website. They must be turned in by the first day of the 2025-2026 school year or your child will be unable to start school.

**Step 2:**

Click on the appropriate link below to sign up for an appointment for your Kindergarten Assessment Transition Meeting with the school your child will be attending in the 2025-2026 school year. The link will take you to SignUp Genius. Your appointment time will be canceled if the online registration (**Step 1**) has not been completed prior to signing up.
