We have several summer research programs, most of which go for ~8-10 weeks, at 40 hours per week. A stipend is provided for all selected interns, applications are at the links below.

Postdoc Positions:

The SLAC Theory Group has an annual competition for postdoc positions, with a deadline in November-December of the preceding year. Our postdocs are usually hired for three-year terms.

SLAC Panofsky Fellowships:

Panofsky Fellowships are prestigious SLAC-wide appointments with a five-year term. They provide generous research support, including funding for a postdoctoral researcher to work with you on your own research program. For this position, you should already have at least some postdoctoral experience.
