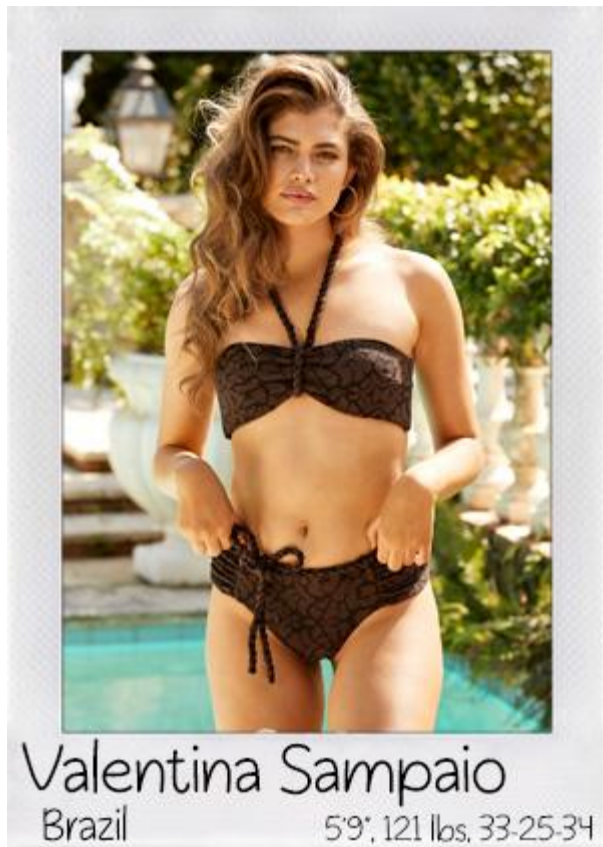
Team Two
