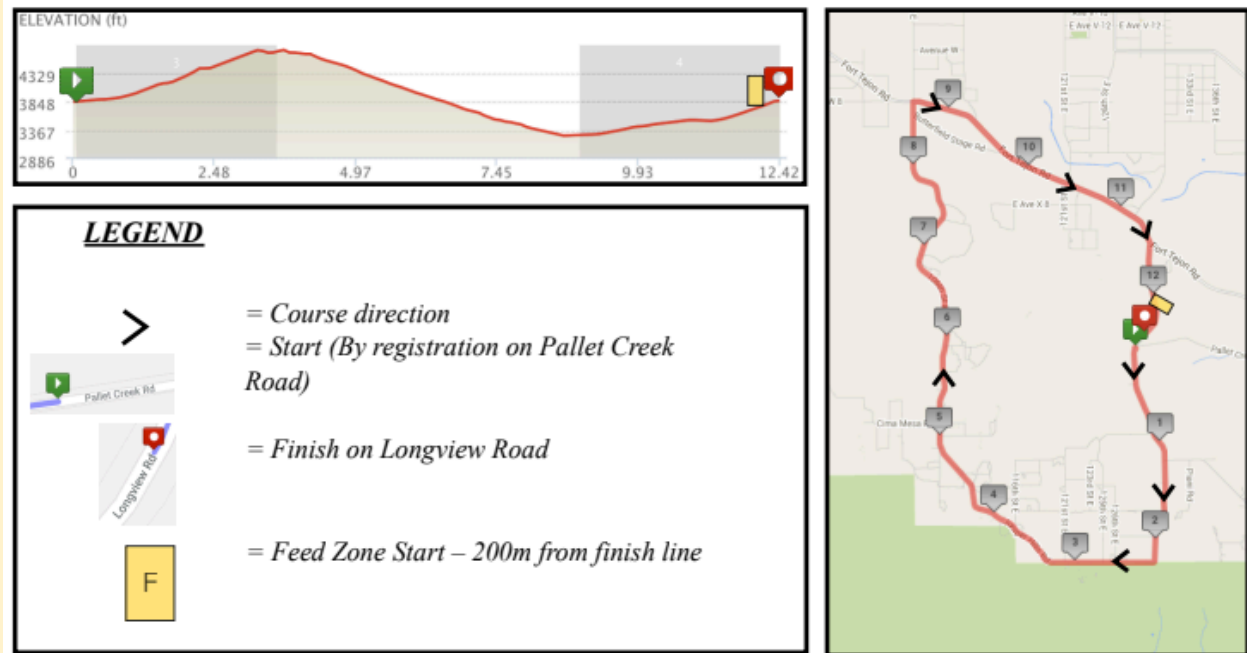

**Registration & Fees:** Same-day registration opens at 7:00 AM, and closes for each event 15 minutes prior to race start times. If you preregister but do not pick up your number 15 minutes before the race start, the number may be given out to another rider. A late fee of \$12.00 will be assessed for any non-collegiate racer for registration received on Race Day. Collegiate racers make checks payable to UC Regents, Team Pay allowed. Mail in registrations are **not accepted** for individuals.

**Registration Area:** Intersection of Pallet Creek Road and Longview Road.

**Pre-registration ends Wednesday, March 6th at 11:59pm PST.**

**Directions:** From CA-14, take Exit 30 for Pearblossom Hwy. Continue on Pearblossom Hwy and take a right on Barrel Springs Rd. Then a right onto Cheseboro Road and left onto Mt Emma Road. Then a right onto Fort Tejon Road. Continue until you reach Pallet Creek Rd and turn right. **PER CHP, DO NOT TAKE A RIGHT ONTO LONGVIEW ROAD.** Park off the road on the dirt. No parking on the course.

**Course:** Clockwise 12.4 mile loop with 1500 feet of climbing per lap, sharp descent, uphill finish. Course is open to traffic. Please respect residents and traffic. Centerline rule strictly enforced, if you cross the centerline **YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.**

**Feeding:** Designated feed zone and specific instructions will be given by Chief Referee prior to the start of the race. No personal follow vehicles allowed per CHP. Wheels in, wheels out. Follow car only guaranteed for: Pro1/2, Cat 3, Pro1/2/3 Women.

**Medical:** Antelope Valley is the nearest hospital. Address: 1600 West Ave. J, Lancaster, CA 93534. Phone: (661) 949 5000. Limited water will be available on site.

**Rules:** Rain or shine. All USAC and WCCC/NCCA rules apply. Helmets must be worn at all times.

<b>Registration &amp; Payment</b>	Online Registration available at <a href="http://www.BikeReg.com">www.BikeReg.com</a> . Online Registration closes Thursday prior to event at Midnight PST. Pre-registration by mail: (info needed [name/race-event/racing category/team/age/email] and payment) <u>must be received no later than Monday of that week</u> . Pre-Reg subtract up to \$20 from Day-of-Fees. USAC waivers can be signed on race day or filled out on <a href="http://BikeReg.com">BikeReg.com</a> . Extra races are \$15 each after the highest race is paid, Except double PRO races are \$25. No Refunds. Fees paid by checks (personal, business, or cashier's), money orders or paper US currency; make payable/mail to: CBR; 2 Eimhurst St Ladera Ranch, CA 92694. Bounced checks will be charged \$50 fee on top of registration. Registration opens 1 hr before 1st race. Race Day registration closes 15 minutes prior to the start of each race.
<b>LEGAL</b>	1) NO Illegal Parking, 2) NO Illegal Urinating 3) NO Illegal Littering. If you are caught doing any of these things that jeopardize the bike race permit, then you will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law, immediately asked to leave & request race disqualification, so DON'T DO IT! We have trashcans, bathrooms & plenty of street parking. Parking in NO-parking spots will be towed at owners expense.
<b>Misc./Rules &amp; Support</b>	Approximately \$6.50 out of every (single entry) fee for insurance & fees. ALL USAC Rules Apply. Crossing over the line of cones used to mark the course will be considered center line violation and will result in <b>Disqualification on first offense</b> , this may be captured by USAC official or rider camera for proof, NO EXCUSES. NO WARM UP will be allowed ON COURSE, bring trailer! Separate scoring: Masters 60+ & Masters W35+ only, they will race together for prizes but are scored separately for daily finisher prizes, medals. <b>(MUST HAVE 9 person field for podium prizes in split fields)</b> . For overall BAR/MAR Series Jersey, categories will be: 40+, 50+, 60+, Cat 4, Cat 2/3, W 3/4/N, M P 1-3, and W P 1-3 categories. Overall Series CASH or merchandise payouts for top-3 in BAR & MAR. Men & Women PRO-1-2-3 Categories, <b>CASH</b> on the Day. <b>EQUAL PAYOUTS for Men and Women's PRO-1,2,3!</b> Guaranteed minimum base purse is \$500 for each Men and Women Fields. <b>BONUS PAY</b> for Men & Women PRO-1-2-3 categories for every rider in each respective field multiply each rider in that field by \$10 and add to base purse.
<b>Course</b>	Course is a FAST, FAST, 9 miles long with 4 turns. The course is closed. Only open to through traffic on Sheriff escort.
<b>Licensing &amp; Other</b>	USA Cycling/AJC license mandatory: Cat 4 or 5 men & women can buy \$15.1-day license. Race held rain or shine, unless unforeseen circumstances determined by race director; <u>uncollectible prizes/cash are deemed forfeited</u> , as well as, anyone that does not show up for podium pictures. Official results at <a href="http://www.OnTheDay.net">www.OnTheDay.net</a> . Series Winners must be present on the Final Race to collect prizes and overall jersey.
