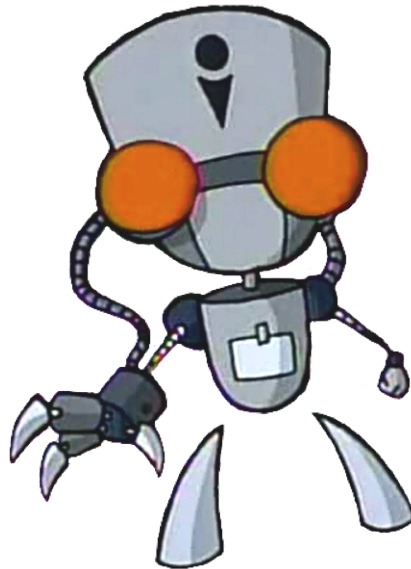
But if the Moron's become such a berserk button for me, why am I riffing another of his fics? Why, to put it simply, *for science!*

SC276: I guess there weren't any black holes available.

so that he might never again recover his power and threaten the worlds with his evil.

SC276: ...Now I'm kinda wishing I played *Honkai Star Rail*. I would have so much material to advance this gag.

For one-thousand years, the threat was long forgotten and only remained in the memories of the past,

SC276: And also this ripoff *Zelda* opening.

but The Grand Ruler struggle against evil continued and Starfleet always would remain on guard for any new or recurring threats to ever rise

SC276: Like the protests about how an unelected billionaire seizing the government's financial data is bad.

This story was passed down for centuries as detailed on the tapestry.

SC276: Yes, the one that, as we will see shortly, is not publicly displayed.



SC276: Behold, the *real* reason Mykan joined FIMFic!

SC276: *I thought he was a "Space Alicorn."*

SC276: Yeah, I kinda figured that from the sentence before it.

SC276: Like (points in a nonspecific direction) that place.

SC276: So... an entire world run by SHOCKER?

Space Alicorns. There were no Earth Ponies, no Pegasi, not even regular Unicorns... Just alicorns

**SC276: (digs through his collection of light novels, pulls one out and flips through it)
...Ah, here: "By the way, from a human's perspective, all dwarf women were lolis."
...Don't ask why I have this volume.**

Each and every one of the alicorns had their own specific ID-Code printed on their clothing near the insignia like Lightning had; sort of like having a citizen number or a alternate name to make you identifiable.

SC276: So, do they have to get this code printed on every bit of torso-wear they own, or does everyone have only one shirt?

SC276: [the author] "I don't know what adults do because I refuse to be one."

**SC276: why did you feel the need to point that out
Also, since everyone has to have their shirts customized to them in order to get their database key embroidered on it, getting a new one would be an entire red-taped affair that would probably discourage most people from ever getting new shirts at all. Some even wore an armor vest under their casual clothes.

SC276: why would they feel the need to wear concealed armor

The planet itself was also a tightly control police state,

SC276: *Boy, did I pick the wrong fucking year to riff this.*

but a benevolent one and not tyrannical.

SC276: According to the propaganda machine.

The streets were always kept clean. Petty or harsh crimes would not be tolerated and subjected to small sentences-- a week of community service, or a night in small prisons, things like that.

C.O.R.N.: ...Well I know what comparison came into my head.

SC276: Public littering? Prison. Jaywalk? Prison. Not saluting the image of Grand Ruler? Prison. Keep in mind, *jails* are short-term incarceration facilities; prisons are long-term. *When Topher had Grand Ruler sending everyone to gulag, that was a FUCKING JOKE.*

SC276: This fic is cause for "degrees."

not too hot, not too cold. so it was practically like Springtime all yearlong.

SC276: [the author] "Fuck weather. Have the weather version of astroturfing."

Lightning was settling into his new house in White Village-- a quiet, soft suburban area, with white houses and simple roofs, but just because it was called "White Village" did not at all mean that only white ponies lived there. All the countries and villages of sorts were named after colors,

C.O.R.N.: Because [SPACE ALICORN]s have no creativity whatsoever.

SC276: More bullshit, probably.

C.O.R.N.: "IT'S NIGHTMARE MOON! EVERYPONY RUN!"

SC276: ...You got out. Without having to fight anything. ...Lame.

C.O.R.N.: [Noir] "But we're winning!"

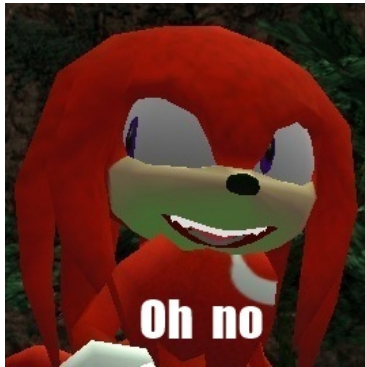
[Titan] "Trust me, you'll have *plenty* of time to have fun once I've gathered enough magic to start the Shadow Line's expansion up proper.

Lightning and his new friends felt confused.

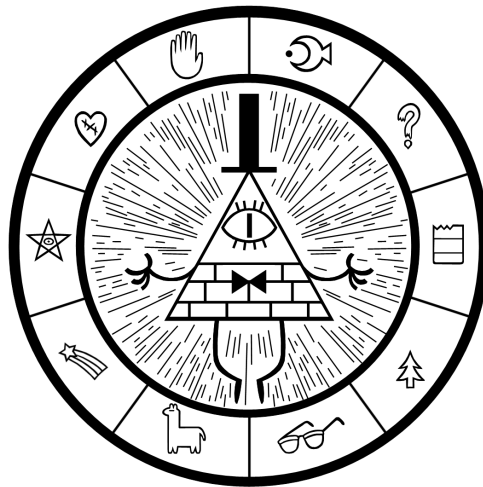
SC276: [Artie] "Lightning, *competent*?"

SC276: [Buddy Rose] "He's not only an evil sorcerer, he's a *ninja*?!"

"If that was only a fraction of his power, I'd hate to see the real Titan." said Artie. Grand Ruler clenched the broken puppet wood in his hand, breaking it to splinters in his grip. "Had this truly been the real Titan, I would have come in an instant.

SC276: Riiiiiight.

I knew you would be able to handle this puppet, however... due to the puppet's appearance and all this trouble; a thing I have feared most is coming true."

He turned to face the others, "You must all listen very carefully to what I am about to say.

SC276: [Grand Ruler] "Which shouldn't be a problem, given I've conditioned all of you to do so at the expense of everything else, including your own safety, but still."

Our world, and many worlds beyond as we know may now be in terrible danger."

SC276: Yeah, the Mykan fic turned out to be even worse than I thought.

He explained that ever since he had fought against Titan a-thousand years ago and banished him into the Dark planet,

SC276: "-he started practicing an Italian accent. He still hasn't quite got it down."

it was always feared that Titan would one day make an attempt to escape and return to finish what he started.

SC276: Since villains are, y'know, like that when they get their asses beat.

"It now appears, that somehow, Titan is regaining his power. Sending this puppet and those three evil ponies proves it!"

He continued to explain that the Dark Planet was, just that-- a very wicked and desolated planet located in the outer reaches of the galaxy.

SC276: Just down the street from Krossos. Absolutely no one is going to get that.

After Titan had been banished to the planet, Grand Ruler used his own powers to shroud the entire planet in a powerful force-field which had kept Titan there for all those centuries.

SC276:





"Now it seems that Titan has grown strong enough to actually weaken the barrier; by puncturing a small breach in it, enough to send these creations after us."

"He was testing us?" asked Lightning.

SC276: [Lightning Dawn] "But I never study! Make him always make it multiple choice!"

"Yes, I'm afraid he was." replied Grand Ruler "Though the barrier may be weakening, Titan is still incapable of freeing himself, but rest assured, from what has happened Titan will attempt to find ways to increase his powers to escape my seal,

SC276: Or find the specific equation that breaks the barrier...

and if he is successful... it will surely mean disaster to all!"

SC276: (pretending to file his nails) Forgive me if I don't feel the adequate amount of dread.

The ponies were starting to feel frightened "We can't let him escape." said Artie.

"What can we do?" asked Starla.

More and more ponies began to panic and stammer about of what to do. "Calmness everyone...!"

Grand Ruler

SC276: It's still kinda funny that after the five years between the original draft and this one, Mykan *still* keeps forgetting and mischoosing words. I mean, yeah, I'm not immune to typos, but these errors are the kind of thing you tend to catch when you, y'know, read your damn fic back.

"As I have said, Titan is still weak and cannot escape himself, which gives us an outside chance.

SC276: Of hitting the corner pocket.

I will be doing everything that I can to maintain the seal against Titan, but at the same time, Titan will also be sending more monstrous creations to attack our world in an attempt to increase his power.

SC276: Using a giant slingshot.

It pains me to say this to you, but I'm afraid I will not be able to join you in battle."

This worried everyone. "But we need you to fight by our side." cried Starla.

SC276: Skill issue.

"We can't beat Titan without you.

Who knows what he may try or do." said Rhymey.

SC276: *shut the fuck up, rhymey*

"You all must understand. Unicornopia is already in enough danger." said Grand Ruler. "As well as maintaining the seal of the Dark Planet, I must also use my power to protect the civilians and innocent ones of my kingdom in times of danger.

SC276: [Grand Ruler] "Also, I *am* still running an intergalactic police force suppressing resistance- I mean, destroying evil, so there's that."

I mustn't strain myself any more than I should have to."

He gazed down at the fighter ponies, "You all and many others with you are officers of Starfleet. It will be your duty like the many you came before you

SC276: I'm pretty sure that's a loop in the inheritance tree.

to fight to defend our world from any and all evil attacks that may come our way."

"Yes *sir!*" the fighters said and saluted to him. Grand Ruler nodded, and then gazed at Lightning. "As for you, Lightning, the time has come for you to take your training to the next level.

...I want you to join Starfleet as well."

SC276: Sure, *now* you say it. Also, I guess Krysta just finished talking.

Lightning was speechless and shocked at first, as were the others, "But... Master... I--"

"I have trained you well, Lightning Dawn, and you have already proven yourself to be a worthy fighter. Though you have no natural magic of your own, you are no doubt capable of performing tasks, feats and doing battle without it, and that with your golden horn, you have the power to tap into the unforce-- the one thing that Titan and his minions fear most."

SC276: Yeah, I'd buy that more if this weren't happening *solely* because of the supervillain breaking loose. Still, (straightens up) now I have an idea of what I'm up against. Meanwhile, he *doesn't* know how I'm getting my power back - and as long as he's so focused on his precious pet project being threatened, he never will. SC276: An extra comma!

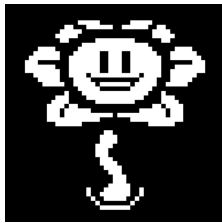
What is this new weapon, and will be able to help defend the planet?

SC276: Because clearly the thing Power Rangers needs is the *WHITE PERSON* in charge. (chugs a tankard of orange juice) Ah, this tea tastes so good.

Though Lightning was initially unsure of being a leader of his own force having not much experience with such responsibilities,

SC276: Or responsibilities at all, to put it mildly.

his master knew he would do just fine, and his master was very trustworthy.

SC276: So if GR told you to jump off a bridge- wait, you can fly, bad example.

Krysta, being Lightning's companion-- with her astonishing ability of strength, she was dubbed as an auxiliary Starfleet fighter; practically Lightning's sidekick.

SC276: [Grand Ruler] "We have to say that to all the other races that throw a fit when we mention slavery. If we don't, they get annoying to subjugate."

Lightning also received two packages from Grand Ruler that day; one containing his new armor vest. It was exactly the same as his old one, only now the insigna had stars around it to show he was a member of the force.

SC276: (flips through the images of the other Starfleet ponies) OK, I don't know whether you forgot to put them on Rhymey or if they got eaten by JPEG artifacts. Also, they're white; they're going to be basically invisible on Lightning's shirt. Yeah, they're visible in his art but that's because you made them black. Also also, you could have just added stars to his existing vest instead of wasting resources making a new one. What, does no one in your little space force know how to sew? Also also *also*, if there's a special signifier that someone's a member of Starfleet clearly visible for all to see, why was Lightning surprised in the last chapter that four of his new acquaintances were members? Especially if he memorized all Starfleet procedures and should have already known this. *But I guess that was a chapter ago, so it doesn't count anymore!*

The insigna itself was replaced with a special-transforming badge... an Energizer...

SC276: Because of course it's called that.

which still had the same marking of a Unicorn and a single wing!

SC276: *I thought they were alicorns.*

A few simple sequenced taps would allow Lightning to change clothes instantly, if and when he was in a hurry and had no time to change by himself,

SC276: -a.k.a. Krysta is too busy making him a sammich or something to dress him-

but only by shouting the command "Starfleet Magic" followed by a single press on the energizer would he transform into Battle-Mode, just like the others did during the fight on the mountain.

SC276: Yes, author, I too have seen *Power Rangers*. As well as half a dozen *Super Sentai* series.

The armor itself composed of a highly density polymerized alloy and infused with Stardust and Cosmic energies; making it hundreds of times stronger than diamond. Nothing could harm it under fifty-thousand degrees and would take a lot of power and strength just to dent it. It was also magically

enchanted; it would amplify the wearer's natural abilities, magic, and weapons, making them stronger and swifter than they were before.

SC276: (playing *Kero Blaster* on his laptop) Yeah yeah, super fighting robot, how interesting or whatever.

The visors, now they were most important piece of equipment. Each visor had a set of various incredible functions.

SC276: *ROBOT ROLL CALL!*

- Heat sensory
- X-Ray

SC276: *Cambot!*

- Infrared vision
- Sound Scan
- Radar

SC276: *Gypsy!*

- Telescopic magnification
- Medical scan

SC276: *Tom Servo!*

- Power scouting
- Database retrieval

SC276: *Croooooooooow!*

Also, all Starfleet suits as well their fighters fought under a specific elemental or attributed force. Lightning's was "The Power of Believing" a very uncommon force among any other, and actually the only one of it's kind to ever be in Starfleet before, but it represent Lightning's courage and determination, propelling him to keep fighting and never stop believing in himself, even when things seemed dire.

SC276: To summarize all that, Mykan doesn't know the term "title."

Lightning almost couldn't wait for his first official battle.
He was however curious about the second package as well.

C.O.R.N.: He found its ticking to be quite pleasant.

It was wrapped with a special magical material, not the kind you could just rip away or open so easily. All it came with was a letter from Grand Ruler...

Lightning...

C.O.R.N.: "Dear Mini-Me..."

You are about to embark on your adventure to help protect our world from that which threatens us. As much as I have faith in you,

C.O.R.N.: You probably couldn't write that with a straight face.

I wish to take no chances for your safety

C.O.R.N.: "Which is why I waited until the scary bad guy went away before showing up."

and therefore feel I should let you have this.

SC276: In material he cannot open. "Take no chances," he says while putting 50 on the snake.

You may not be able to open this package just yet, but all shall be made clear to you when the time is right.

C.O.R.N.: "At least I assume so. It's the only conceivable reason I, God, couldn't open it."

I have complete faith that you shall be one of our greatest assets in the fight against Titan and his evil forces.

SC276: "Which should be evident from that being the only reason I hired you."

Learn well and strong, my apprentice, and keep on believing.

C.O.R.N.: "Specifically, in me. I'll figure out how Celestia does the mind-control thing eventually."

Your caring Mentor:

C.O.R.N.: (laughs disgustingly)

Grand Ruler.

"Huh! I wonder what it is." Lightning said as he shook the package trying to figure it out,

SC276: Aaaaaaaaand you broke your Christmas present.

but he decided to just leave it be for now. He had other things to attend to.

C.O.R.N.: Namely, starting a cult of personality centered on himself.

Though he was an official Starfleet member now, he still had a normal life to live, and needed a simple job to pass the time, earn some extra money as well as make a little living outside the force.

SC276: Wow, this intergalactic police force *can't even give their soldiers a full-time living wage?! I thought Mykan lived in Canada!*

So he decided, and became a *community worker*; he would go around and help others at their work or do menial tasks for others.

C.O.R.N.: That job sounds like the vocational equivalent of the drawing the parents put on the fridge so everyone can see it.

The entire planet was now well aware of what was happening, that Titan and his forces were out there and willing to strike again, but with Starfleet on constant alert and patrolling the areas for any signs of danger, the civilians lived in not too much fear and still went about their daily lives; it was better than living in fear and staying in hiding all the time.

SC276: Because it's so easy to not be unreasonably afraid when you're constantly surrounded by armed armored figures you could do literally nothing to protect yourself against if they turned on you for any real or imagined reason.

Some Starfleet officers did aerial patrols, others were walking beats on the streets, and others were on sentry duty in lookout towers. If anything evil came to the planet, they'd have to be pretty slick to avoid being seen!

C.O.R.N.: As such, no one noticed or remembered White Village when it sunk into the darkness and became part of the Shadow Line.

Still, Unicorniopia was also a planet of law-and-order, as was said before, crimes, hostile acts and such things were not tolerated. Everyone wanted to live in civil peace and good-relationships, but if the law was broken, depending on the severity, there would be consequences.

SC276: Author, I already know about your *motherfucking fascist police ethnostate*. You do *not* need to remind me of it.

...

...

...Also, unless you're Lightning or the Starfleet officers that let what was at the time a civilian come along on a mission because he refused to leave.

Lightning pretty much was starting to get used to his new life, but he never neglected his training and exercise to keep strong,

SC276: [Mykan] "What training and exercise did he do? *Fuck you, that's what!*"

nor his studying to gain more knowledge of the world and galaxy around him, but most importantly the uniforce. It wasn't like anything he had ever seen or studied before.

SC276: Because this idiot that dances his way into the middle of a street is known for studying.

What was the Uniforce really? Where did it come from? How did he tap into it before, and how could he do it again?

SC276: Exodia using Obliterate, Yu-Gi-Oh!, because the author wrote enough of the fight to fill his "timeslot," and the next time the author writes enough of the fight to fill his "timeslot." Next question.

He still had no idea how to summon it like he did in the battle against the Titan-Puppet

SC276: Skill issue.

Unfortunately, he searched all over the library, but not one of the books had the information he sought. He was starting to feel a little frustrated. Inquerius was passing by and saw him studying hard again. "Are you frustrated, Lightning?" she asked.

SC276: No, I'm pretty sure "Lightning" is his *first* name.

"I don't think "frustrated" is the word?" Lightning sighed "Do you have any other books that can help me find what I'm looking for?"

"Do you really think that what you seek can be found in a book? That such a rare and extremely powerful force has been recorded." asked Inquerius.

SC276: [Question-girl] "At least, in a publicly-available library? Would you not think that our glorious leader would want to keep all intelligence about his until-you unique spell classified?"

"That's what I'm asking you!" snapped Lightning.

SC276: [Question-girl] "Oh dear Celestio, why must he be so *thick*..."

He apologized quickly for being rude, "But please, can you just help me out?" Inquerius felt confused, "I have not been helping you already?"

C.O.R.N.: [Lightning Dawn] "No, no you haven't."

Lightning was getting so frustrated at all those questions,

C.O.R.N.: [Mykan] "You hear that?! Stop asking me to justify my choices!"

but Artie was passing by with some books he was returning told Lightning "You haven't been around very long, and I don't think you quite get it here.

SC276: [Artie] "You're slow like that."

You see, her name is Inquerius; "Inquerius" like "inquire" or "curious." She *doesn't give answers*, she *asks questions*. It's the way she talks.

SC276: Author, you're aware the only decent character to speak like that was a B-list supervillain from a kid's show about vocabulary, right? ...C.O.R.N. is definitely not going to playback the end rant and you know it.

Just like how Rhymey rhymes all the time, at least he does it less annoyingly." He chuckled softly,

SC276: Wanna bet?

but Rhymey looked up from his book and scoffed teasingly.
"Less annoying, eh?
My rhymes are okay."

SC276: *shut the fuck up, rhymey*

Lightning got the drift now.

C.O.R.N.: [Lightning Dawn] *"That's the stupidest fucking thing I've ever heard."*
[Artie] "I don't think so. She's never been called to jury duty in her life."

Inquerius helped others by trying to get them to realize the answer for themselves; like answer a question by asking a question. A rather bizarre, but somewhat effective way to get certain things.

SC276: And what if they want *anything besides those certain things*? What, does the fascist ethnostate consider all that forbidden knowledge?

C.O.R.N.: What is with authority figures and avoiding work in this universe? This lady's taking lessons from Wally. Or, given her strategy is clearly "annoy them until they go away," the Warner Brothers.

"Is there not something else you can do instead of pondering over this mystery?" asked Inquerius.

C.O.R.N.: [Inquerius] "You know, instead of blocking the *entire aisle*?"
[Lightning Dawn] "Lightning Dawn doesn't get answers, *no one does*."
[Inquerius] "This third-person thing better be temporary, right?"

Krysta fluttered near her friend and suggested he take a break go get lunch. "You've been working too hard, Lightning. You really should relax."

SC276: [Krysta] "Just repeat to yourself: it's just a fanfic."

Lightning felt that was laughable.

C.O.R.N.: [Lightning Dawn] "Me, work hard? *HA!*"

How could he relax at a time like this when he had so many unanswered questions tormenting him, as well as worrying what Titan was up to now?

C.O.R.N.: "I just wonder what Ganon's up to."

But just then, his stomach gurgled he complied with what Krysta said.

SC276: His stomach's more obedient than he is. Which all things considered is rather concerning.

The Dark Planet was, as its name suggested, an eerie, dreary, fearful place

SC276: Shut up, Lady Redundant Woman.

with dark thundering skies. The grounds were littered dark soils, burned trees, and the bones of dead bodies decaying.

SC276: Good. Dead bodies *not* decaying is how you get vampires.

Just the ideal place to keep an evil demon like Titan imprisoned all those centuries,

SC276: Everyone knows the best place to keep someone evil is surrounded by evil. Especially if they get more power from evil.

but in all that time, Titan had slowly begun to rebuild, and in the center of the planet

SC276: That sounds physically questionable, though in comparison to everything else, it's pretty low on the list. Also lets me keep the purple void background.

stood a tall and spooky dark castle, his home and base of operations for the past millennium.

C.O.R.N.: Specifically, this castle:



SC276: [Titan] “(speaking into a microphone) Hello, and welcome to *Lifestyles of the Evil and Twisted*, with your host, Titan! Today, we’re seeing the lair and machinations of our special guest, Titan! Let’s take a look around. This here is Castle Terminal, central nexus of the Shadow Line. This baby was built to take over the world with darkness and trains before yours truly made a few tweaks and took the whole operation intergalactic. Mostly by cannibalizing the Astral Express when they got too close.”

Over the ages, Titan worked hard to restore his power, and break Grand Ruler’s barrier on the planet and escape;

SC276: [Titan] “I gotta give GR this, when he seals someone on a planet, he *really* seals them on a planet. I can’t get anything made with my power off this rock! But

that's the key word: *my* power. He forgot to make that seal work on *anything else*. And since I won Castle Terminal and the Shadow Line in a card game, the seal completely ignores it, no problem. I got Kuros and Shadows working 'round the clock on the surrounding frontier planets, carting darkness back here on Kuliners. And when the imports are running scarce, well... let's just say I know where all darkness in *this* planet is buried."

So far all he had succeeded in was creating a *small rift* big enough to send his minions or puppet-clones of himself through, but not great enough for himself.

SC276: [Titan] "And *boy*, you think eating your spinach makes you strong, nothing beats Castle Terminal-processed darkness! Took me like two hundred years to get the refinement process down pat, but it was worth it! (sips goblet) *Ahh...* The perfect mix of salty tears and bitter regrets. I get five dozen morning eggs worth of strength on my daily doses of this sweet black gold. I'm strong enough now that I managed to punch a hole in GR's stupid seal. Once I got a track out to his Unitropia or whatever, I was able to get some of my own personal creations on it. And now the game's *really* started."

In order for him to escape, the entire barrier would have to be brought down

SC276: [Titan] "'Will GR notice all this?' you may be asking? (*raspberrys*) Not a chance. Some other gang beat the previous owner, so that nimrod has no idea what to even look for. Most of my operations are outside places his fleet even remotely patrols; they don't have nearly enough copy-paste freaks to cover the *entire* universe. And as long as there's a threat on his little pet project of a planet, he's not going to think about *anything else* but the stuff on it and settling for reinforcing my seal from the remote comfort of his sky palace instead of checking in himself. Bottom line is, I know how to hide from the law. I've been around for nearly two thousand years, so I know lots of things. **LOTS OF THINGS."**

Now understanding what his course of action was.

SC276: [Titan] "We'll be back with more *Lifestyles of the Evil and Twisted* after this commercial break!"

He summoned his minions before him in his massive throne room.

C.O.R.N.: [Titan] "I realize I'm sitting on a house of cards right now, but don't worry - those cards are made out of all the Shadow Kaijin I 'retired' when I took over the Shadow Line."

The minions bowed,

SC276: "-briefly questioned why the disco ball was still there-"

and Titan explained his plan, "My experiment in sending that puppet to gather energy from the alicorns has proven a success. Even now, the rift in the force field is expanding as my power grows, which greatly weakens the barrier itself,

SC276: [Titan] "-making me the perfect allegory for global warming-"

but if I am to effectively escape I shall require more power, which means more energy drained from those ponies and the world around them.

SC276: [Titan] "The darkness festering in the slums of GR's *stupid dumb-dumb idiot* planet is so rich, I almost got a contact buzz! A steady supply from there, and ripping this stupid barrier down will only be a matter of *months*! Maybe even *weeks*! So we are going to get that darkness at *any* cost!"

Do you understand?"

Mysterious bowed to his master "We understand completely my Lord Titan. We will not let you down."

SC276: [Nero] "We will totally fail you now!"

Dementia nodded, but Rep-Stallion scratched his head in confusion, "Uh, not trying to question orders, but can't we just get stronger in secret and then strike those punks again?"

Dementia nudged him softly and growled "We're going to explain it to you one last time, so pay attention! One of the first rules of combat is... Don't underestimate your opponent!"

SC276: [Schwartz] "But they make it so easy!"

"Dementia is correct." hissed Titan "That is mistake I intend not to make a second time,

SC276: Well, are you Russian or not?

therefore we stick with my plans. By doing this will not only gain more energy and power, should Starfleet spring into action we shall study them and learn of their skills and power, making it easier to crush them in our own time.

SC276: [Titan] "If there's one thing that hasn't changed about GR in a thousand years, it's that he couldn't hold someone else's secret if he *tried*. He doesn't value intelligence, and like with any war, that will be his undoing."

However, if we destroy them beforehand, that's fine too."

Mysterious and Dementia nodded, and Rep-Stallion nodded too finally understanding. "Tell us my lord." Mysterious asked "How shall we carry out your wicked will?"

Titan snickered sinisterly

SC276: [Titan] "The old owner's methods have been doing pretty well on the frontier with the minimum resistance, but we don't have the Shadow Kaijin to spare sending to Ground Zero just to get blown up. Which is why I have *another* idea."

and in his hands he conjured up a sack of magic powder he entrusted to the minions. "This dust contains one of the more darker spells. Sprinkle it over any inanimate object and you will see." He snickered sinisterly.

SC276: Snickered sinisterly snickered sinisterly, snickered sinisterly. Snickered sinisterly? Snickered sinisterly!

Lightning and Krysta had finished their lunch and thanked Cookie Dough.

C.O.R.N.: [Cookie Monster] "Good, despite being bigger idiots than Grand Ruler, you know the script."

but Buddy Rose stopped and froze on the spot. He looked very grim all of a sudden. "My folks... they died a few months ago."

Hearing this stunned Lightning and Krysta.

SC276: I should probably have a similar emotional response, but after the "fascist ethnostate" realization, you're not getting anything else out of me.

"Oh, I'm really, sorry." Lightning said.

"It's okay, you didn't know."

Buddy Rose explained how

SC276: [Lightning Dawn] "I didn't ask for-"
[Buddy Rose] "I am threatening you with a shotgun, SHUT UP AND LET SOMEONE ELSE TALK FOR ONCE."

a few months ago he had graduated from the Starfleet academy, while his parents had gone off to the planet Yale, where his older sister, Iris, was attending college.

SC276: Cute. Cute planet name.

[Buddy Rose] "Yes, Krysta, but you have to understand: this is my focus chapter, and nothing about it is ever going to be relevant to anything later."

[Krysta] "...OK, yeah, fair."

SC276: Echoing off what, the insides of their heads?

SC276: Neither do I, but we don't always get what we want.

C.O.R.N.: [Mykan] "This is *totally* cinematic! I'm gonna get two thumbs-up for sure!"

It was a flower exactly like the Beauti-Flors in Buddy's pictures; only it was at least twenty feet tall, with dark eyes, sharp, prickly vines, teeth...

C.O.R.N.: So, it *doesn't* look like a Beauti-Flors- (GAGS VIOLENTLY)

SC276: I'll be real, when I first read the original, my brain rendered Blossomon independently of PanzerThiefZero's suggestion.

C.O.R.N.: Given the *Digimon* thing, you're probably on the money there.

It also ran in the ground itself by its roots and tore everything in its path as it went. Lightning and Krysta backed away, and then they heard the sound a familiar laughter, and Dementia appeared, levitating in the air. "Hi...!" she teased.

C.O.R.N.: [Lightning Dawn] "...are you flirting with me?"

SC276: He stopped being upright at some point?

and waved his arms

SC276: -like an inflatable tube-man.

SC276: This is going to get old fast, I can tell.

Dementia snickered and gently patted the small sack out powder on her belt. "What, giving up already?" she teased.

C.O.R.N.: Yeah, can we get back to imitating the pilot? I can get material from that.

SC276: [Lightning Dawn] "No fair, the Rider Kick's supposed to be a finishing move!"

SC276: You think you're annoyed...

SC276:

C.O.R.N.: Right. Lightning, help.

SC276: Which begs the question of why the rest of the squad isn't showing up, besides this taking long enough as it is.

C.O.R.N.: [Noir] "Maybe he can use the others as extrapolation points, or maybe as railroad ties. Either point, *KILL.*"

and the monster charged. "Run!" shouted Lightning, and the gang dashed away only to have the monster start chasing them.

C.O.R.N.: And now back to the situation we were in before, only with more heroes being useless. ...Also, that is one *damn fast flower.*

"All right, that does it!" snarled Buddy "There're only one way to deal with a bad bud like this!

"Aw... what's the matter? Out of options are we?" teased Dementia. Then she used her powers to free her monster and make it stand up right again.

SC276: [Mykan] "How can a wave cut a vine? Fuck you, that's how!"

"Uh oh...!" cried Krysta, but just as the monster was about to charge in something sped past it. "What now?" Dementia sneered

SC276: She's as done with this bullshit as we are. ...I am. ...I am incredibly lonely.

as she and the others saw the object hover before Lightning "Hey! It's that package I got from the Grand Ruler."

C.O.R.N.: [package] "You dare leave me behind, asshole?! You know how hard it was to get here when I can only teleport like three feet at a time like a Weeping Angel being watched through a film camera?!"

Indeed it was, and the wrapping around it magically vanished

SC276: [robot voice] "Disengaging plot-based time lock..."

C.O.R.N.: [package] "And now I'm dead, I hope you're fucking happy!"

revealing a small golden scepter with a golden ball on time, and encrusted with rows of colorful jewels, all the colors of the rainbow.

SC276: ...That looks even more like a bad dildo than the *original* Rod.

"*Lightning...!*" echoed a voice.

"Grand Ruler...?" Lightning cried, but his master was nowhere to be seen; only his voice was heard.

C.O.R.N.: *Fucking hell, he can turn invisible now.*

"If you are hearing this magical message, means you are ready to take possession of this

SC276: -magical-

item.

Although you are strong and swift, brute strength alone will not always be enough to help you. You may be able to tap into the uniface, but you have much to learn before you truly can master it.

SC276: [Grand Ruler] "I'm not going to *help* you learn any of that, because frankly you weren't paying attention during the *first* decade."

*Therefore, until such a time, I give you THIS to assist you in battle.
This is the Rainbow Rod.*

C.O.R.N.: *And if you confuse it with the Star Rod, Kirby eats you.*

I created it centuries ago, and in time it has become infused with great power that should be extremely helpful to you.

SC276: Like how juice turns into wine, a.k.a. becomes completely undrinkable.

When the time is right,

SC276: *is this your favorite phrase or something*

and you have strength enough,

SC276: This is a new condition, and judging from this Memo from the Future, this is pretty much solely so the Uniface gets used at all going forward.

simply recite the chant inscribed on the rod,

SC276: ...somewhere...

C.O.R.N.: *And then drop the bass-bass-bass.*

and unleash the Spectrum Stream."

SC276: [Lightning Dawn] "So, you're giving me a weapon, but it's only capable of delivering a finishing move, requiring that my teammates spend all their time protecting me for the entire battle while I hang around uselessly? ...This is the perfect match for me."

[Grand Ruler] "I know, right?!"

Heeding his master's message, Lightning took hold of the rod,

SC276: So he firmly grasped his master's rod, ha ha ha, I miss Topher.

C.O.R.N.: [Krysta] "Y... You guys saw that, right? It just exploding like a cheap video game boss?"

Dementia couldn't believe what has just happened,

C.O.R.N.: [Noir] *"are you goddamn shitting me"*

but she decided to flee while she had the chance. "You'll pay for this!" she snarled as she vanished and was gone.

At least the village was safe now and the damages would be easily repaired. Buddy Rose even gathered up all the flowers he could carry and planned to take them back to his garden.

SC276: Shut the fuck up, Peppa Pig.

Back in Titan's lair, Dementia was struggling hard to make herself look pretty again after all she had been through, much to the annoyance of her fellow minions.

SC276: I'll give this draft this: Dementia isn't whining about her makeup being ruined every five seconds.

C.O.R.N.: Back at the castle, she grabbed a tub of ice cream and sat down to watch TV, only to have trouble watching because guess where Titan was building his railroad planning model.

Titan however was no too disappointed

SC276: -that he no take candle.

that Dementia had failed in her mission to destroy Lightning. She still got him the energy he needed. The force of the battle was so intense that each and every time an attack was used more energy was unleashed, giving Dementia the chance to secretly absorb it and take it back with her to give to Titan so he could weaken the seal and increase his own powers.

SC276: Yep. Totally that. Not darkness being generated from the citizens due to the stress and despair from a monster attack in the supposedly super-safe police society, then taken back to Castle Terminal along the Shadow Line by Kuliners for Titan to process and consume. Definitely totally the thing hiding information from the audience. By the way, where the fuck did everyone in Red Village go this time?

Furthermore, Titan now knew the existence of Lightning's rainbow rod.

SC276: He couldn't help but wonder how he would handle his Rod, ha ha ha, I miss Topher.

It was all just too perfectly laid out.

SC276: *Suspiciously* too perfect.

Win or lose; Titan would always get what he wanted. He couldn't help but snicker softly.

SC276: [Titan] "This cheap Xanatos impression definitely isn't going to backfire one day."

Once back in Rainbow City, Buddy Rose went straight back to his garden and planted all his new flowers into place. "Beautiful." He remarked. "Simply beautiful..."

SC276: [Brain] "Hey, my catchphrase has a *patent*, mister."

and he handed Lightning a bouquet of flowers for his home in White Village, free of charge. Lightning almost felt embarrassed "It's not really normal for a male to give another flowers." he joked.

SC276: That implies Lightning is capable of humor. Also, insert Kamen Rider Beast reference here.

Buddy Rose agreed, but it was his job "You guys helped save my hometown, as well as helping me get these flowers. Now my business will go up twice as much."

**SC276: [Lightning Dawn] "What business?"
[Buddy Rose] "I don't know why you think I'd ever tell you."**

Lightning and Krysta were also grateful to Buddy. He showed up just in time to help them, and that was what Starfleet was all about, helping one another, and working as a team.

SC276: Which is why the rest of yours didn't show up.

C.O.R.N.: So not only is Mykan an Italian, he doesn't even know how to type his own accent?

C.O.R.N.: Y'know, for a culture that has a yearly exercise day, its members suck at actual exercising.

SC276: I've heard of being in love with your carnage, but this is ridiculous.

He didn't even know his own wife was a Starfleet member

SC276: That is literally impossible unless literally every single shirt and chestpiece she wears is white. The fucking stars are *right goddman there*.

until he found out some years after they were married and Starla was born, this was another one of their bigger arguments, being on the force, and blaming his wife for putting ideas into Starla's head when really it wasn't her fault.

SC276: It was Starfleet's fault. That's how propaganda works.

Some villains Starfleet captured and brought to justice in hopes there was a chance to redeem themselves,

SC276: "Justice" is what they call the old missile silo they kick them into. And yes, they play the Sparta remix every single time.

but other non-living types like the Floralbite, which had no hearts or souls and could never be reformed or were too powerful to be contained,

SC276: We have a term for that, author, we call them "Object Class: Keter."

they were destroyed and for good reason; to stop them before they hurt any innocent beings...

SC276: Boy, it must be nice to absolve yourselves of every atrocity you ever commit.

...But as usual, her father's stubbornness, ignorance and stupidity continued to show. *"Why can't we just talk with them, convince them to stop all this? I'm sure they'd listen."*

SC276: That sounds like a question that enough people bugged Mykan about in MLU that he gave a character another traumatic backstory just to vent about it.

Lightning and Krysta felt sick to their stomachs at such stupidity. "I know he had good intentions but... reasoning with creatures THAT evil...?" groaned Lightning.

SC276: Having played a D&D cleric that made a warlock pact with a demon prince, you're just jelly.

SC276: No, that's eating the sun. Don't you know anything about Penn and Teller?

and were locked outside, forcing themselves to run far from the battle area, except Starla's father naively thought this was his big chance to prove himself right and how he could try reasoning with the bulls.

SC276: Y'know, display zero situational awareness.

He approached one of the big brutes...

"*Get outta my way, punk!*" the creature growled.

Starla's father, feeling a bit nervous and quaking in fear at the sight of the big beast, tried to reason with him. "*Look... SC276:

SC276: Y'know, when he said he wouldn't be able to join them against the MotW, you'd think it's because he's doing something *more* important. Especially since if this was also the case during Starla's backstory, him personally controlling every single shield means there was a good chance he could have just... let the two of them in anyway. Rep then reached behind him and held out a single ordinary rock he had found,

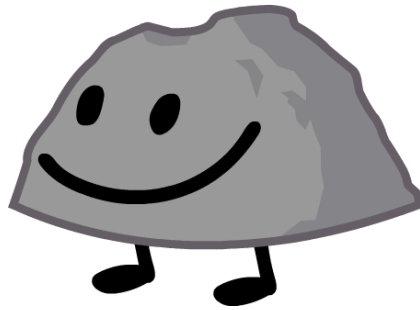
C.O.R.N.: Because fields don't have rocks in them.

C.O.R.N.: [Krysta] "...What?"

[Lightning Dawn] "Ew, I hated that game! It had a baby in it and it wouldn't shut up when the game had the gall to damage me!"

Now go Strong Stone;

SC276: I got better: Wrecking Ball.

get them!"

The monster pounded its huge feet which actually caused tremors which nearly knocked Lightning and Starla off their feet. They got up quickly and nodded at each. It was time to transform!

SC276: *It's morphin' time!*

"Starfleet Magic!!"

"Power of Believing!"

"Look!"

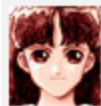
Strong Stone looked way up, and opened its huge mouth firing blazing meteor stones straight up at them,

SC276: It's really so interesting that Mykan insists on Lightning doing hand-to-hand combat when he refuses to describe hand-to-hand combat.

Strong Stone continued to fire the meteors at the girls. The girls just continued to swerve and evade the shots, but they couldn't keep it up. Somehow they just had to find out the monster's weakness.

C.O.R.N.: *Oh so they can't dodge forever like Lightning can.*

C.O.R.N.: [Krysta] "Your mother was a hamster and your father smelt of elderberries!"

Flying one way, then another-- up and down, every way around--

C.O.R.N.: *~Up and down and all around~*

She was pretty fast, and her small size made her hard to see and follow. Strong Stone was getting dizzy,

C.O.R.N.: SC276 was getting disconnected from the boring action.

but angry as well, and opened his huge mouth to fire another meteor at Krysta. Starla saw this from where she was hovering "Now's my chance; **STAR BOW!**" She pulled out a purple, solid, sharp-edged bow.

SC276: So, the Attache Arrow from Kamen Rider Zero-One. Hey, Mykan's already stealing from everything else, why *not* the future?

Rep-Stallion saw this "Hey, what's going on?"

"I think I know..." Lightning said.

"STARLIGHT ARROW!" Starla fired a glowing blast from her bow straight into Strong Stone's huge mouth, finally causing real damage. Sparks and small explosions emitted from its body, and it groaned in pain.

SC276: Unbelievable! These characters actually do the *smart* thing for once! ...That is, act like they're in a *Zelda* game.

C.O.R.N.: ...So, let me see if I got this: the monster isn't beaten by having its own hard rocks drop on its head like a *reasonable* cartoon.

"No way!" cried Rep.

"That's it!" said Lightning

C.O.R.N.: [Krysta] "Your approval fills me with shame."

SC276: [Dr. Eggman] "No way! I can't *believe* this!"

"We did it!" hollered Lightning. The girls cheered for joy and then Lightning turned to face Rep-Stallion,

SC276: -to find he was now throwing dust on all the pebbles. No wait, that might be *interesting*.

"Your turn now...!" but before he could act, Rep-Stallion decided to split. "I'll be back! Just you wait!" then he vanished and was gone.

C.O.R.N.: Exactly like how Spectre Knight does it.

Lightning growled in frustration that Rep had escaped.

C.O.R.N.: And whose fault is *that*, wise-acre?

The important thing was that everything was okay now. No serious damage had been done to the park.

SC276: Oh sure *NOW* you call it a park.

The force fields were lowered and everyone was allowed back outside again.

"An extraordinary performance, Rep-Stallion." mocked Mysterious "And all you return with is a tangled tail." added Dementia.

"You guys take that back!" shouted Rep.

SC276: [Schwartz] "I can take those kinds of words from the master, but not from you two!"

SC276: [Titan] "Daddy has a headache, shut up before I decide popping all of you would beat popping a Vicodin!"

The minions quieted down and bowed apologetically. Even though Rep-Stallion had only gathered a little energy, Titan was pleased nonetheless.

SC276: [Titan] "I was doing some experimenting of my own, and despite GR having eyes all over, he did *nothing* about White Village becoming a Shadow Town. It'll probably take me another episode to double-check, but this could make things a *whole* lot easier on that front..."

"Every little bit counts. It only makes me stronger." he hissed "And the day draws near when I shall have all that I need."

SC276: [Titan] "That said... Rep."

[Schwartz] "Yes, my lord?"

[Titan] "You suck at making coffee. (throws a '#1 Evil Overlord' mug of lava in Schwartz's face)"

[Schwartz] "*SCREAMING*"

Lightning walked Starla home to her home in Rainbow City.

SC276: Because White Village is already occupied by a main character.

Starla thanked Lightning and Krysta for all they did. "You did well too, Starla. I can see you with astronaut wings yet."

Starla smiled "Thanks." she said

SC276: [Starla Shine] "So you're going to use your pull with Grand Ruler that made you my boss after one fight to fasttrack my way to the space program?"

[Lightning Dawn] "Oh *fuck* no."

and she pecked Lightning on his cheek before she headed inside.

SC276: With a bird she grabbed out of the air.

Lightning's face turned bright red. Krysta giggled "What's the matter, Lightning?" she teased.

SC276: [Krysta] "Is your head about to explode? It better, I can't murder you for my freedom directly."

Lightning could barely speak and just stuttered and slurred words all the way home.

SC276: He had too much moonshine. He wasn't sure how he got moonshine in the first place, he just assumed GR gave him anything he had that he didn't remember getting.

That night, before going to bed, Lightning wrote his report...

C.O.R.N.: It's that time again!

"Although we've have once again thwarted another attack, it cannot be denied that Titan and his followers are proving to be pitiless enemies that will go to any lengths to fulfill their dark ambitions.

SC276: Not sure why you need to tell him, it's not like he's not observing every fight from on high to get the force fields up.

At this point, until we can study more about them and their evil powers, there is little any of us can do but rest, wait, and maintain constant alert for oncoming attacks that can and will occur as this war continues.

SC276: "a.k.a. be lazy as fuck, and not take advantage of the fact that Grand Ruler is just watching the planet 24/7 to realize where the Shadow Line connection is."

Facing the strong stone

SC276: As opposed to the weak brick.

has giving me the realization and intention to increase the effort of my physical training to improve my ever-growing strength in battle while also keeping my mind focussed.

SC276: Good, because judging by your spelling, you clearly need it.

C.O.R.N.: Wheel of Morality, turn turn turn, tell us the lesson that we should learn!

Excessive exercise is not beneficial for anyone and can prove to be quite dangerous to one's health, but it can also not be ignored that in battle strength is not necessarily everything necessary to win, but also the knowledge and wisdom that goes with it."

SC276: So you intend to use your nepotism to get out of future Fitness Days?

He signed his name, then sent the report through the magic mailbox slot which would send it all the way to Grand Ruler's floating palace in the sky.

SC276: The entire ending? Really? You stock-footage'd an explanation.

After that, he hopped into bed, and turned out the lights and dreamt of all the adventures he would have another day.

SC276: And don't wake up.

(Promo)

In our next episode; a rainy day

SC276: Come to think of it, if the world's weather is astroturfed, how the fuck does it have a rainy day?

turns out to be an opening opportunity when Mysterious launches a new plan to gain energy for Titan, and demonstrates his own uniquely made monsters that are unlike others Lightning and his friends have faced.

SC276: So is he implying that each minion makes monsters with inherently different properties based on who made it, like how the Greeed work in *Kamen Rider OOO*? But there's not really much different behavior-wise between Bloomsday and Wrecking Ball. In fact, Titan provides all the dust, which is what does the thing; the minions just apply it. The only difference would be due to him giving them each different kinds of dust, and like... why would he even *bother*?

What is Mysterious' plan, and how will Lightning and friends be able to face this new type of monster?

SC276: This fic is already a wet noodle.

And that's the end of part 1 of this experiment! And... *wow*. My general statement that Mykan's remakes are worse than the original was a general extrapolation of vibes. I did not know until now with my own eyes just *how* bad they could get. No wonder Ring never ran this thing, which I kinda always lowkey wondered about. C.O.R.N.'s calculating how much of my old material it was able to recycle, it'll read that off at the end, so let's go over my end of this.

There *are* some things that are actually better than MLU, to be fair. There's no songs... yet. Rhymey isn't in chapter 3 arbitrarily, always a plus. Dementia isn't a whiny vain bitch, with her single character trait toned down to normal Mykan-character level. There's an attempt to designate Rep as the thick-headed muscle to better diversify the cast, even if that really doesn't work for a guy wielding a scythe, but it's an effort at least. Wrecking Ball's defeat is far less convoluted. Lightning keeps his Rod in his pants, ha ha ha, I miss Topher.

Everything else, though, is basically the same, if not abominably worse. Most of these I don't think I can meaningfully address without reading further, so we'll touch on a few points specific to these five chapters here.

The organization of Starfleet as presented so far is just baffling to me. For a supposed military organization, nothing about it seems functional as one. Apparently everyone is so used to making magic weapons that no one ever thought to stock an armory with normal weapons that don't require magic just in case there's a situation where they can't use magic, leaving a squadron with no way to actually win a fight until its leader gets a magic wand that's useless for over 95% of any given battle. Actually, "squadron" is the wrong word; what Lightning's leading is a team. "Lieutenant" is not an entry level rank; it's the lowest level of commissioned officer - the army's *managers*. They're not supposed to be actually fighting. *This stuff is Googleable.* Fitness Day is even fucking weirder here. Like, even limited to just Starfleet members, military institutions put their soldiers through physical drills a *lot* more often than once a year, especially since the constant invasions means Unicornopia is always at war and they need to be ready to scramble at any time. And they need to get the civilian doctor to oversee it instead of an actual fucking drill sergeant? Militaries are not made of *just* the bodies that get thrown at the enemy. *Power Rangers* series where the Rangers are part of a larger organization like in *Beast Morphers* and *RPM* show multiple supporting background characters doing things that aren't fighting - managers, logistics, R&D, maintenance, battle cleanup, et cetera. Starfleet has the guys on the watchtowers, but that's pretty much it - an enemy general and a monster appeared in a park in *the biggest city on the planet*, and the mentioned constantly-alert patrols *don't even fucking show up*. If Brain invented most of their tech, why isn't he officially a part of the organization? Isn't having this guy outside a secure Starfleet location a massive security risk? Why do those inventions not include shield generators, instead of relying on the *leader of the entire army* to be available at a moment's notice and could damn well be off-planet at any given time? *Does Mykan know logistics exists?* My knowledge of how militaries work could be summed up by the contents of the Oversimplified YouTube channel, and it's still more than this story that's ostensibly about a military!

There's also something weird I noticed now that I'm seeing the text with bold for the first time. Whenever a new character is introduced, did you notice Mykan bolds and italics their name? Y'know, like they stand a chance of missing it or something? However, this is only the case for the non-alicorns; for them, their *code* is bolded instead (with the exceptions of Inquerius, who has neither highlighted, and Brain, who has both; probably a mistake). Which implies those codes are their *actual* names, and the names we've been using are just nicknames, like how the Beagle Boys were referred to by their prison numbers in their pre-*Ducktales* comic appearances. *I don't think you want your heroes compared to the fucking Beagle Boys.* I thought Rhymey saying his name was XL7Zed was just a fucking verse thing, but it might be his *actual legal name*. Does Mykan think government databases use *someone's name* as the key to identify someone specific? The smallest number I could get for the number of people with the name "John Smith" after a minute of Googling was still 25K. Imagine, a couple with a newborn goes to register the birth

certificate and the name they've heartfully invested in for the better part of months just to be told "This username is already taken."

And then there's Lightning Dawn. Lightning was always something of a pinball protagonist in MLU, but it just gets amplified here. He lacks a clear goal that he can meaningfully pursue on his own, only reacting to major plot developments made by other people - he never *wants* anything for *himself*. Everything is set up for him, and the only thing remotely resembling a meaningful decision he makes is going after Titan - and his agency in *that* is toned down here because of Krysta's kidnapping. This is compounded with him going full nepo-baby, which sums him up not only here, but in pretty much all of Starfleet, and "Starfleet Humans" especially. Everything he wants, Grand Ruler provides; which is interesting, considering he's such a pinball that he never actually wants anything. Every time he does something right, Grand Ruler rewards him disproportionately. Every time he does something wrong, Grand Ruler shields him from the negative consequences and doesn't give him a chance to learn anything from his mistakes. Another experiment I thought of while doing this is search-and-replacing "Grand Ruler" with "God" and seeing how little it actually changes anything.

Though speaking of disproportionate reward, there is just something skeezy as hell about the way Lightning's introduction to Starfleet is handled. He's the apprentice to the leader of Starfleet, so presumably all the training he received while living with GR was to eventually join Starfleet. That's how apprenticeships work, it's working for someone to learn a trade or craft; it's not just another term for a type of personal student. And yet when Lightning leaves the palace because reasons, he doesn't go to Starfleet; the topic doesn't even come up as a possibility. He's just kicked down to the surface, into a house GR prepared specifically for him, and he presumably would've stayed there, getting a normal job and living a normal life (for, y'know, a fascist ethnostate), if Titan didn't show up. Isn't it just a *little* suspicious that the moment Lightning shows that he can cast the same spell that only the God claimant should be able to cast, *suddenly* said God claimant starts using their power and influence to nepotism him into a position he has strict control and full oversight of before any dissenters make him an antipope? Neither reason GR gives for not intervening in chapter 2 really exclude the other Starfleet cadets that were already there. If GR *actually* saw the potential for the Uniforce in Lightning from the beginning, why wouldn't he put him in the Academy right after he moved out? He certainly has no problem getting him there *afterwards*! Mykan probably didn't *intend* to make it look like GR dumped his magicless failure of an apprentice until he started being a useful tool and potential threat to his political position, and then setting him up to die just in case with a weapon that's useless for 95% of every battle, but that's how it reads!

Many of these issues would not be present if Mykan just rewrote the story from scratch, instead of obviously just editing the story he already wrote. Not only are there several identical passages, they have outdated terminology and the same typos. The same *obvious OBVIOUS* typos, that should have very much should have been caught on a second read that the author evidently didn't do while copy-pasting everything. (Then again, it's arguable whether the author even does a *first* read.) The military mishmash is because despite the obvious PR theming, it's structurally *still* a magical girl battle show. The bolding was probably the same as it was in the

original release and he forgot not to bold Brain's new long name while adding it. GR's sketchy treatment of Lightning is only because it's still doing the MLP pilot ripoff. This is the wishy-washiest way to reboot something. For a rebooted work to make the most of any improvements you want to add to it, you need to start with a clean slate; I speak from experience here. Like, I don't know how to emphasize it other than pointing out you removed the time you mixed up Krysta and Starla, only to do it again later in the same chapter in a *worse* way. If I didn't know better, I'd swear you did it on *purpose*!

C.O.R.N.: Hello, and welcome to standing up school...

And then, my final note: the "you read MY fic by MY rules" author note, which was also one of the statements he vandalized my *E-QUEST* riff with though that didn't have the "MY preferences" bit. This shows a fundamental misunderstanding of how media literacy works. Like, there is no way to interpret this that makes him look good. Yeah, sure, he can write whatever he wants, everyone can, but that doesn't mean I have to *read* it the way he wants. How someone responds to something - particularly art - is an intimately personal and unique experience that cannot in any reasonable way be controlled by the creator of the thing. Sure, creators can and often do aim to get a particular emotional response from their audience, but even aside Mykan being the ultimate television cargo cultist and absolutely not knowing how to do that, that's not the same as demanding control over the audience's perception of the performance.

This is happening because he fundamentally *cannot or refuses to understand* that literature - including fanfiction - does not communicate the same information or information in the same way as television. It's like the garbled graphics and broken behavior an old video game displays when it tries to interpret its graphics data as runnable code. He wants everyone to see the exact same show he's made up in his mind, and it has somehow not occurred to him that he can't do that with just text, and a smattering of pictures and YouTube links is not going to make up for an actual animated show. It's hard for artists to look objectively at their own work and what it communicates because they're biased by knowing what they were trying to communicate, and if Mykan was the kind to take the hard route, the story wouldn't have *huge patches of MLU with incompatible lore* in it. And when everyone expectedly doesn't have the exact same vision he has of his work, he's somehow *surprised* that we can't read his fucking mind, and compensates by acting like he can force us to *think* like him.

C.O.R.N.: And so all the "animation" is cheaper than 12 oz. Mouse.

Every time I read this story, Lightning Armor is played by Shining Armor, Krysta by Navi, Cookie Dough by the one-wheeled robot from *SteamWorld Heist*, Inquierius by Maud Pie, and Titan by Bill Cipher, No Heart, some combination of the previous two, or Old Cob depending on how my brain's feeling at the moment; the same way that every time I read *Artemis Fowl*, Artemis is played by Tails the Fox, Butler by either Kirby the vacuum cleaner or some form of Kingpin if he's in the middle of wrestling somebody, Holly by Blankey the electric blanket, and Juliet by a girl character with green hair and a wok on her head from *Fighting Foodons* that I don't know the name of, I only saw like one episode. No amount of official art will ever change that; Harry

Potter has his face on the cover of every book, but that didn't stop me (back when reading them was socially acceptable) from picturing him as either Paper Mario or Tails again anyway. I also don't tend to imagine specific voices from other people for OCs either, so celebrity cast lists like at the end of MLU are a waste of my time. The way I run the performance in my head - and the ways everyone else runs theirs - is *none of the author's fucking business*.

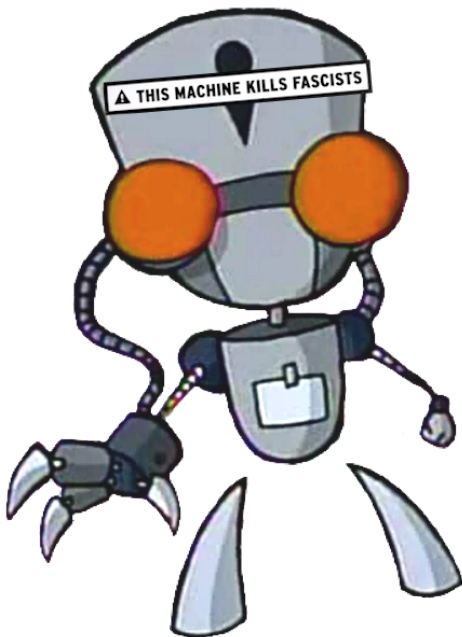

C.O.R.N.: That's *your* problem, starchild; leave us out of it.

Mykan trying to enforce reading his work in the way only he wants it to be read is not only trying to put himself in an echo chamber, it's trying to get everyone else to build the chamber around him because he can't be fucking bothered to do it himself. Even if it's just something as innocent as wanting to give a television show experience via text like how Nick Smith wanted to give the experience of a classic computer RPG via text, it fails because the very premise itself is fundamentally flawed. And at least Nick knows how to proofread. Jesus Christ, dude, *go outside and touch grass*.

C.O.R.N.: If you don't write about what you don't understand, why are you trying to write *prose*?

And we're only a sixth of the way there. Next time on MLU MK II: the filler cycle continues! See ya next time!

SC276: Now, before we conclude for today, I have one last thing I want to settle. To do so, I've invited a special guest. Please welcome my friend and Fan/fic/ Theater 3015's resident Starfleet expert, PanzerThiefZero!

PanzerThiefZero: Glad to be here, SC! And what a coincidence you just so happened to invite me to this for this segment; that 2017 riff of *Magic is Believing* was my first real foot in the door that led me to where we are today. And *by golly* I feel like 90% of my riffs did *not* age well especially all the parts where I made myself say 'eff' in lieu of 'fuck' because something something unprofessional something something I thought that was a good compromise for saying fuck ergo shit like 'shut the eff up Rhymey' something something I was an effing moron. A lot of the shit I did in the earlier riffs (at least up to part 5, where I'd argue I really found my groove) was out of a shitty 'Mykan bad because he said the ponies smell, please like me' phase that even places like Project AFTER was getting sick of at the time and because I thought hating on Mykan for the sake of hating on Mykan would make me one of the cool kids.

Needless to say, Legendbringer in the same riff constantly crying 'but in the remake, this character does/says this!' and/or bitching about how Mykan couldn't write for peanuts *ad nauseum* did at least play a good role into snapping me out of *that* mentality. And shit like *Fall of Starfleet* helped cement it further.

But even to this day, while I'd argue that the whole shit about Mykan, his hatred of MLP, and *especially* his seething hatred for things like the *Teen Titans 2003* finale and Twilight Sparkle is practically a dead horse of a topic at this point, I still find a lot of his writing to be utterly *fascinating* to read, even today, because, looking past his seething hatred of the funny horse show, you wind up with more wild shit like 'one-shot antagonist commits Pony 9/11 because something something parents performing science experiments turned her into a hard worker, pity her' and 'cool brooding antagonist who's the best *Yu-Gi-Oh!* player ever in-universe unironically uses the *Pepsiman* theme during a chase scene', and now 'love interest had to pay her way to get to elementary school all by herself all by the age of 14 because *realism!*' It's bonkers, it's batshit wild and it's *oh so entertaining for all the wrong reasons!*

SC276: That is like six times longer than I budgeted for my attention span, but we're gonna roll with it. Glad to help you with your redemption. Now, I've described

Unicornicopia - and, by association, United Equestria - as a "fascist ethnostate" in this riff. I think the "ethnostate" part is uncontestable. Even from just what I've seen from the group riffs, they destroy the culture of the Equestrians they assimilated with things like forcing everybody to say "everybody" instead of "everypony," and you've told me about them shittalking cutie marks to put it mildly. As well, the only non-alicorn in the story so far was made to live in the walls of the upper caste and then forcibly made his subordinate in the military hierarchy, and of all the things I've heard about the series, with the exception of Spike, *none* of them are about the *other* sentient species that were on Equestria or its planet when GR annexed it. Not to mention it's pretty skeezy that this intergalactic organization policing all the beings of the cosmos seems to only employ *one* species of alien, and the one non-alicorn we've seen so far is in an "auxiliary" a.k.a. "subservient" position. Your thoughts on this?

PanzerThiefZero: Well, honestly? It's really hard *not* to see it; we already had the shit seen in the first four chapters of the fic, not to mention the *other* shit you just brought up.
