**Quality Support Coach Roles and Responsibilities:** Participate in a variety of Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) process.

Discuss and determine up to 2 tasks that will be your primary focus in your role as a QSC.

### Continuous Quality Improvement with After-School Staff

- A. Engage in collaborative planning with After-School Site Coordinator and Principal, in support of continuous quality improvement and school day alignment: minimum 2 hours/month.
- B. Work in partnership with site coordinator and school leadership to gather and analyze student data to inform program planning, identify student participants, and assess student progress.
- C. Participate in the after school program's *Assess-Plan-Improve* continuous quality improvement process: help program staff gather data as part of self-assessment; help staff review data and identify areas for improvement based on the data.
- D. Participate in development and implementation of After School Quality Action Plan; coach and train staff to improve in specific areas identified in the Quality Action plan.
- E. Provide classroom observations, coaching support, and trainings to improve staff practices and program quality based on Program Quality Assessment (PQA) standards.

### Academic Support in After School

Provide academic leadership and guidance to increase student learning—e.g. developing intentional and appropriate academic components that are aligned with school day efforts that does not duplicate school day.

- Review the OUSD Program Planning Tool for after-school to identify targeted academic supports based on student data and needs.
- Help develop after school academic offerings that align with the Common Core standards and/or with Linked Learning/Career Pathway initiatives at secondary sites.
- **(For elementary sites)** Sites are required to provide 1-hour of literacy and 1-hour of math. School can use district-developed elementary after school literacy and/or math curriculum; train staff on curriculum; observe and coach staff on effective facilitation
