Gala Conditions

- 1. Meet to be held at Bedale Leisure Centre the Pool length is 25m of variable depth with 4 lanes & anti-wave lane ropes;
- This meet is an Invitational meet with only 4 Clubs allowed to attend. This will be at the discretion of
 meet organisers. Swimmers who have qualified for Home Nation or British Nationals should be
 excluded from this event.
- 3. Colorado GEN 7 Electronic Timing will be in operation with scoreboard display. Times displayed are for information only
- 4. An external strobe light is available for hearing impaired swimmers upon request
- 5. Age groups/Events will all be Heat Declared Winner. There will be no medal presentations due to this being a time trials meet
- 6. Ages are as at 31st December 2023 (for rankings purposes only)
- 7. Entry fees: £4.00 for Sports Systems entries. Coach passes cost £0
- a. Due to the competition running during NASC training hours, NASC swimmers will receive a discounted entry fee for the meet.
- 8. Coaches will not be permitted on poolside without the necessary pass
- 9. Entries must be submitted on the official entry file. Entries should be returned by the entry **closing date:**Midnight 5th January 2023
- 10. Payment to be made by BACS by the entry deadline provided. Details on the summary page attached.
- 11. Northallerton ASC will **NOT** be responsible for any unaccompanied swimmers on the poolside. The responsibility falls on the club entering the swimmer, who should appoint an individual to be on the poolside i.e. an adult with a coach's pass
- 12. Heats will be seeded according to submitted entry times
- 13. For safety reasons only swimmers who can perform a Swim England competitive start may perform a shallow racing dive from the starting blocks. Where possible, over-the-top starts will be used during the meet. Swimmers are requested to remain in the water until asked to leave the pool
- 14. Admission for spectators will be; Adult £3.00. https://nasc.co.uk/spectator-nasc-jan-23/
- 15. No entry cards will be issued. Coaches or Team Managers should advise the recorders of any missing swimmers by 7pm Saturday 9th July. Seeded heat start lists will be produced prior to the start time of the session. Complying with this condition will keep the number of empty lanes to a minimum
- 16. Poolside entries, £5.00, may be permitted if the meet has not been over-subscribed
- 17. Should the competition become oversubscribed, swimmers will be excluded from fastest times first, within each age group.
- 18. Coaches/Team managers are responsible for ensuring competitors report to the marshalling area at the required time. Swimmers failing to report to the competitive marshals in time for the start of their race may not be allowed to compete
- 19. Anyone found damaging or misusing property or equipment at the host venue may be disqualified from any further involvement in the competition and may be subject to further action from the Pool Management
- 20. Neither Northallerton ASC nor BedaleLeisure Centre (Hambleton District Council) can be held responsible for loss or damage to spectators' or swimmers' property. Swimmers are advised to use the lockers in the changing rooms and not to leave belongings unattended in the changing area or on poolside
- 21. Anyone wishing to use photographic equipment within the pool area must register at beforehand
