

Merry Christmas Book Fold Card



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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets** – Delicate Pines (166067)*; Jolly Holly (166117)
- **Paper** – Basic White Thick Cardstock (159229); Old Olive Cardstock (100702); Basic White Cardstock (166780); Elegant Pine Snowflakes Designer Series Paper (166066)
- **Stamp Pads** – Real Red (147084)*; Old Olive (147090)
- **Misc.** – Delicate Pines Dies (166073); Branching Out Dies (165775); Early Espresso & Old Olive Linen Thread Pack (165986); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Save by purchasing the Delicate Pines Bundle (166074).

Measurements:

- Basic White Thick Cardstock: 4 ¼" x 11"
- Old Olive Cardstock: 3 ¾" x 2 ½"
- Basic White Cardstock: 3 ½" x 2"; 2 ½" x 1 ½"
- Elegant Pine Snowflakes Designer Series Paper (DSP): 1" x 4" (pattern 1); 4" x 4" (pattern 2); design with pinecones to die cut

Instructions:

1. Score the 4 ¼" x 11" cardstock at 4 ¼" and 5 ½".
2. To create the card base, fold and burnish at the 5 ½" score line. Then apply adhesive between the 4 ¼" score line and the 5 ½" fold line, close and press to seal creating a book fold.
3. Attach the panels of the Elegant Pine Snowflakes DSP to the card base.
4. Die cut the Old Olive cardstock and the 3 ½" x 2" Basic White cardstock using the two smaller Branching Out Dies.
5. Stamp the sentiment using the stamps from the Jolly Holly Stamp Set onto the die cut Basic White cardstock panel using the Real Red Ink Pad leaving room to add the pine needles and pine cones. Attach to the Old Olive die cut and add to the card front (on top of DSP Pattern 2.)

6. Use the Old Olive Ink Pad to stamp the pine needles from the Delicate Pines Stamp Set on to the small piece of Basic White cardstock. Die cut with the coordinating Delicate Pines Dies.
7. Die cut three pine cones from the Elegant Pine Snowflakes using the Delicate Pines Dies.
8. Tie a double bow loop with the Old Olive Linen Thread and attach to the sentiment panel with a mini glue dot.
9. Attach the pine needles and two of the pine cones to the card front over the bow using Stampin' Dimensionals and mini glue dots. Add the third pine cone using a Stampin' Dimensional below the right side of the sentiment.
