Article IV— Elections

B. Qualifications

1. Candidates must have and maintain a 3.0 grade point average with no failing grades in any subject during the school year of the election to run for an officer position and 2.5 grade point average for Senators and Representatives.
2. Candidates will have no out of school suspensions, and no more than two detentions and/ or In- School- Suspensions during the school year of the election.
3. Candidates must secure 3 teacher recommendations from his/her any teacher past or present within Melbourne High school.
4. Candidates who want to run for President of Student Body must previously serve on student government in have held at least one officer position within the past three years, and chaired at least one committee
4. Candidates for Student Body President must be entering their Senior (Fourth) year of high school and have previously served on Student Government in an officer position and led at least one committee in the past three years.
5. Candidates seeking re-election must receive approval from the class of which they currently serve.

6. Candidates for an officer position must be present on-campus for the majority of their class schedule.

D. All candidates will be given equal opportunity to campaign to the student body.

E. Speeches may be required by candidates seeking election to a position of any officer of the Student Government, Class President, and Class Vice President.

F. Voting for Student Government officers, Class Officers, Class Senators, and Class Representatives will be in accordance with state adopted voting procedures and supervised by the Student Government sponsor(s). A candidate is considered the winner of the election by receiving more votes than the other candidates for that position. In the event of a tie, a runoff election will determine the winner of the election.
