We hope everyone has a great Christmas and an enjoyable winter break family!



PBIS Update

There has been a lot of time put into our Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS) program by our intervention team. We still have a lot to accomplish, but we have met at least 70% of the tiered fidelity requirements for all three PBIS tiers set forth by the Ohio Department of Education.

School buildings are required to meet at least 70% of the requirements for each tier by the end of the 2022-2023 school year.

Tier I: 96.7% Tier II: (88.4%) Tier III: (73.5%)

PBIS Data as of 12/14/22

2021-2022- After 73 school days, 114 discipline incidents.

2022-2023- After 73 school days, 79 discipline incidents.

Discipline issues are down 31% from the previous school year. The building goal is 50%. The majority of referrals come from a very small handful of students. There has been significant improvement in several of our students that exhibited problem behaviors last school year.
