- Title should be in 14 pt, bold, and centered.
- Author names should be in 12 pt, centered, with superscript numbers for affiliations.
- Affiliations should be in 11 pt, italic, centered.
- Abstract text should not exceed 300 words, justified alignment.
- Include up to 5 keywords, separated by commas.
- Page size: A4 with 2.54 cm margins on all sides.
