## BACKGROUND

- Multiple projects with demands and not so well coordinated
- Mission creep - featuritis - [2nd system syndrome](#)
- Need to make the TeSS a shared responsibility

## OBJECTIVES

- TeSS DevOps - development, operation and curation - clustered around a TeSS Club
  - Squaring the circle of aggregator of third party contributions (active and passive) with strategically presented curated content
  - Collections

  - Better than Google in finding training materials
