Table Tennis Term 3 2026

The Intermediate School Table Tennis Competition for year seven and year eight students is played on Wednesday evenings during terms three.

Venue:

North Harbour Table Tennis Association, 5A Akoranga Drive, Northcote. (Behind the YMCA)

When:

Games are played between **5.00pm and 7.00pm** on Wednesday evenings. The competition for Term 3 starts on Wednesday 29th July 2026 and runs for Term 3.

Trials and Teams:

There are NO trials for table tennis. Teams comprise 3 players per team. Teams can be all boys, all girls or mixed. Teams can have reserve players listed, however only 3 players per team can play matches on a Wednesday evening.

Each player gets to play five matches per night. Matches are the best of 3 games (sets) up to 11 points. Players are responsible for umpiring.

Team and Individual Registration options:

Learners are welcome to make up their own teams of 3 players. If you choose to make up your own team, please make sure that you know the names of the other players in your team before registering on Kindo. During the registration you will be asked to fill out the name and surname of the other players in your team. This is so we can match up your registrations when forming your team and when entering your team with the organisers.

If you do not have a team or only have two players, you will have the option to register as an individual. Please note this during the registration process on Kindo so that the school can try to help you make up a complete team. Please note that we cannot guarantee that we will be able to form a team for you, as it is dependent on the number of individual registrations received.

IMPORTANT:

We are limited to sixteen team entries per school. This will be on a first in first served basis. Please make sure that you have all the members of your team correctly named on your Kindo registration so that your team can be correctly formed and entered into the Wednesday night competition.

Fees and Registration:

To develop compassionate, global, **connected** learners who strive for **excellence** through **action**.

The cost is **\$45** per player per term. Fees are non-refundable after teams are finalised and published. To register your child and pay the fees, please go online to [Kindo shop](#) and select “2026 Term 3 Table Tennis Competition” under *Sports Teams Fees*. The online registration process needs to be completed by **5.00pm Wednesday 22nd July 2026**. Please make sure that you register in time, as late registrations cannot always be accepted. Only players who have registered in time will be put into a team.

Managers:

Each team will need a parent volunteer to manage the team. The manager sends out reminders to the team, makes sure there are enough players each week and passes on any communication from the organisers and/or the school. If you would like to volunteer for either of these roles, please do so during the online registration process.

Uniform:

TNIS PE uniform and non-marking shoes. Players will need their own bat.
